



## Satan came to STEAL your HEART, KILL your BODY, and DESTROY your SOUL in Hell

Theme: JESUS came to give us LIFE (HOLY SPIRIT)

Apostle Kelvin Godfrey Franklin Preached September 18, 2022

NOTE: I am sharing my sermon notes to aid those studying this sermon. It primarily contains my significant thoughts and provides the passages of Scriptures studied in preparation for the sermon. Many of these items are thoughts the HOLY SPIRIT spoke to my heart during my preparation period.

Monolog: The last time I was here, I spoke of my Journey. I am continuing my Journey, and I pray that you are starting to find your Journey. We have been:

- Saved out of Egypt (the world) (Jude 1:5)
- We need to **journey through the wilderness** (live our lives) in faith
- So that we might be **accepted into the promised land**. (only 2 made it, Joshua & Caleb, of those over 20 years old) (*Num. 32:11-12*).

#### We must get the Terminology Right to be successful in the Kingdom of Heaven

- 1. The wrong terminology will lead to wrong results and end in the destruction of the soul in Hell
- 2. Satan confused the commandments that GOD had given to Adam and Eve
- 3. Result: they ate the fruit, and they DIED

#### **Apostle Carter shared this with me on 16 Sep 2022**

- 4. It's not a building; the LORD wanted to fill
- 5. It's our hearts
- 6. This empty space is what He wanted (to fill) all along.

I responded: YES, the LORD wants to DWELL in man's HEART!!

#### (From my Audio Tape recording of a dream I recently experienced)

- > I had a dream about an older teenager who was seducing younger children to leave the dock and right down a flight of stairs to a boat ramp that was under the dock, where he would kill them
  - It was a dream, and I did not try to stop but observed them thinking that now we have the evidence of who was committing these murders
  - Someone pulled the body out of the water and burned it thoroughly, so there was no evidence
  - I was then saying, "why did I not show anyone? Because now the deceased body (evidence) is all gone."
  - Then, I woke up and asked the LORD what this meant.





The Scripture, St. John 10:10, came to mind.

#### ST. JOHN 10:1-11

- 1. Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that entereth not by the door into the sheepfold, but climbeth up some other way, the same is a thief and a robber.
- 2. But he that entereth in by the door is the shepherd of the sheep.
- 3. To him the porter openeth; and the sheep hear his voice: and he calleth his own sheep by name, and leadeth them out.
- 4. And when he putteth forth his own sheep, he goeth before them, and the sheep follow him: for they know his voice.
- 5. And a stranger will they not follow, but will flee from him: for they know not the voice of strangers.
- 6. This parable spake Jesus unto them: but they understood not what things they were which he spake unto them.
- 7. Then said Jesus unto them again, Verily, verily, I say unto you, I am the door of the sheep.
- 8. All that ever came before me are thieves and robbers: but the sheep did not hear them.
- 9. I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture.
- 10. The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.
- 11. I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.

The LORD showed me that this **Scripture** is not related to this world – but to the Kingdom of Heaven

Last time I discussed the three (3) discipleship ages

- > ONE: Adam to JESUS' birth
- **TWO:** JESUS' birth to His crucifixion, resurrection, and ascension into Heaven
- **► THREE:** Outpouring of the HOLY GHOST on the Day of Pentecost until the 2<sup>nd</sup> appearing of JESUS CHRIST for His Bride, the NT Church

Satan came to steal our hearts, kill our bodies, and destroy our Souls

#### Satan came:

- Steal your heart away from GOD (that's what he did to Adam and Eve)
- o Kill you (before you can repent)
- So that your soul is destroyed in Hell

#### But JESUS came

- o To give you life by paying the price for your sins,
- o that you might repent, (FOR THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN IS AT HAND)





- o that you might be brought to life again by the breath of GOD, and
- o that you might live the rest of your life, eternally with the FATHER in Heaven

#### This revelation just blew me away!!

Remember when we (me and Ramona) were talking to Ramona's high school classmate recently, She kept saying, "I agree with you." She kept saying, I agree with what I was teaching.

- > I was giving her the heavenly interpretation of the Scriptures
- We have been teaching the principles of GOD for the philosophical advancement of man and ignoring that everything is rooted in the Kingdom of Heaven
  - We have been teaching based on this life
  - Everything in the Scriptures was written about eternal life and how we get there
- We have been preaching that Scripture and referencing how Satan has been stealing from us, and we are going to take it back; we missed it
- ➤ The stealing that Satan is doing is he is stealing our hearts
- 1. Satan steals our hearts, and it causes us to sin
- 2. The wages of Sin is death
- 3. But the gift of GOD is eternal life

#### FEAR HIM WHO IS ABLE TO DESTROY BOTH BODY AND SOUL IN HELL

#### **St. Matthew 10:28**

- 28. And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in Hell.
- ➤ The **KILLING** is of the **BODY**
- > The **DESTRUCTION** is of the **SOUL**

#### SATAN STOLE ADAM AND EVE'S HEARTS IN THE GARDEN

## 1. FIRST, LET US DEFINE THE HEART

#### IMAGINE BREAKFAST

- o I NEED TO EAT
- WHAT DO I WANT
- WAFFLES, EGGS, BACON

#### **GENESIS 6:5-6**

- 5. And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
- **6.** And it repented the LORD that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart.





- 7. And the LORD said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air; for it repenteth me that I have made them.
- **8.** But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD."

## 2. Let us define Lust in the Scriptures

This Scripture explains how lust is defined for NT Disciples.

1 JOHN 2:16 - "For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world."

#### 3. Let us Define Sin

This Scripture provides the NT definition of sin.

1 JOHN 3:4 – "Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law."

## 4. Let us examine the commandment given to Adam & Even

This Scripture shares the commandment given to Adam when he was created.

GENESIS 2:16-17 - "And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat: but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die."

#### Let's See How Satan Stole Adam & Eve's Heart

**GENESIS 3:6** - "And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat."

#### **LUST - STEALING OF THE HEART**

- 1. Lust of the flesh that the tree was good for food
- 2. lust of the eye and that it was pleasant to the eyes
- 3. Pride of life a tree to be desired to make one wise

## 6. James teaches the pattern of Sin

James explains how temptation leads from lust to sin and death.





#### **JAMES 1:12-16**

- 12. Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the LORD hath promised to them that LOVE HIM.
- 13. Let no man say when he is **tempted**, I am tempted of God: for **God cannot be tempted** with evil, neither tempteth he any man:
- 14. But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed.
- 15. Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth Sin: and Sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.
- 16. Do not err, my beloved brethren.

## 7. Adam and Eve Separated from GOD

- > The LORD killed an animal (most likely a sheep) and made coats of skin to cover their nakedness
- ➤ The **LORD separated them** from His presence and removed them from the garden
- The **SPIRIT of GOD within them died** because they had defiled their temple with Sin

#### **GENESIS 3:20-24**

- 20. And Adam called his wife's name Eve; because she was the mother of all living.
- 21. Unto Adam also and to his wife did the LORD God make coats of skins, and clothed them.
- 22. And the LORD God said, **Behold, the man is become as one of us**, to **know good and evil**: and now, **lest he put forth his hand**, and **take also of the tree of life**, and **eat**, and **live for ever**:
- 23. Therefore the LORD **God sent him forth from the garden of Eden**, to till the ground from whence he was taken.
- 24. So he drove out the man; and he placed at the east of the garden of Eden Cherubims, and a flaming sword which turned every way, to keep the way of the tree of life.

## 8. Sin brought about the Death of All Mankind

Adam's original sin brought about the death of all mankind.

#### **ROMANS 5:12-17**

- 12. Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by Sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:
- 13. (For until the law sin was in the world: but Sin is not imputed when there is no law.
- 14. Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over them that had not sinned after the similitude of Adam's transgression, who is the figure of him that was to come.
- 15. But not as the offence, so also is the free gift. For if through the offence of one many be dead, much more the grace of God, and the gift by grace, which is by one man, Jesus Christ, hath abounded unto many.





- 16. And not as it was by one that sinned, so is the gift: for the judgment was by one to condemnation, but the free gift is of many offences unto justification.
- 17. For **if by one man's offence death reigned by one**; much more **they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.**)
- 18. Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to CONDEMNATION; even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto justification of LIFE.

(Rom 3:23 KJV) For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

(Rom 6:23 KJV) For the wages of Sin is death; but the gift of God is ETERNAL LIFE through JESUS CHRIST our LORD.

#### 9. JESUS died on the cross for our Sins

JESUS CHRIST died on the cross and shed his blood to pay the price for our sins. (St. Matthew 27:48-51) JESUS is the Lamb of GOD who died to take away the world's sins. (St. John 1:29)

#### 10. JESUS had to leave so the HOLY GHOST could come

JESUS had to depart so the HOLY SPIRIT (the HOLY GHOST) could come into the world.

#### ST. JOHN 16:7-13

- 7. Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.
- 8. And when he is come, he will reprove the world of Sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- 9. Of Sin, because they believe not on me;
- 10. Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more;
- 11. Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged.
- 12. I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now.
- 13. Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will show you things to come.

## 11. JESUS breathed on His Disciples

JESUS breathed on His Disciples and commanded them to receive the HOLY GHOST before he ascended back into Heaven.

#### ST. JOHN 20:20-23





- 20. And when he had so said, he showed unto them his hands and his side. Then were the disciples glad, when they saw the Lord.
- 21. Then said Jesus to them again, Peace be unto you: as my Father hath sent me, even so send I you.
- 22. And when he had said this, **he breathed on them**, and saith unto them, **Receive ye the Holy Ghost**:
- 23. 23 Whose soever sins ye remit, they are remitted unto them; and whose soever sins ye retain, they are retained.

## 12. NT Church was born on the Day of Pentecost by the HOLY GHOST

The HOLY GHOST birthed the NT Church on the Day of Pentecost. JESUS paid the price for the New Testament (New Covenant) with His blood. However, the NT Church was not established until the Day of Pentecost. Therefore, NT Disciples MUST begin to study the NT Scriptures containing the commandments that JESUS sent to guide those who would follow Him.

#### **ACTS 2:1-5**

- 1. And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.
- 2. And suddenly there came a sound from Heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.
- 3. And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.
- 4. And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.
- 5. And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under Heaven.

## 13. NT Disciples are Now the Temple of the HOLY SPIRIT and GOD

The HOLY SPIRIT no longer dwells in buildings. The bodies of NT Disciples are the NT Temples of the HOLY GHOST! Therefore, we must maintain our bodies in sanctification (in purity) because the HOLY GHOST will not dwell in DEFILED temples.

#### **1 CORINTHIANS 3:16-18**

- 16. Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?
- 17. If any man **defile the temple of God**, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which temple ye are.
- 18. Let no man deceive himself. If any man among you seemeth to be wise in this world, let him become a fool, that he may be wise.

#### WE ARE BONES OF CHRIST'S BONES, AND FLESH OF CHRIST'S FLESH

#### **1 CORINTHIANS 6:15-20**

15. Know ye not that your bodies are the members of Christ? shall I then take the members of Christ, and make them the members of an harlot? God forbid.





- 16. What? know ye not that he which is joined to an harlot is one body? for two, saith he, shall be one flesh.
- 17. But he that is joined unto the Lord is one Spirit.
- 18. **Flee fornication**. Every Sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body.
- 19. What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?
- 20. For **ye are bought with a price**: **therefore glorify God** in your **body**, and in your **Spirit**, **which are God's**.

#### 14. REPENTANCE is a CHANGE of MIND

Repentance means a change of mind. (**G3340. metanoeo**, met-an-o-eh'-o; from G3326 and G3539; to **think differently** or **afterwards**, i.e. **reconsider** (mor. feel compunction):--repent.)

#### 1 JOHN 1:1-10

- 1. That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, of the WORD of LIFE;
- 2. (For the **LIFE** was manifested, and **we have seen it**, and **bear witness**, and show unto you that **ETERNAL LIFE**, which was with the FATHER, and was manifested unto us;)
- 3. That which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have **FELLOWSHIP with us**: and **truly our fellowship** is with the **Father**, and **with his Son Jesus Christ**.
- 4. And these things write we unto you, that your joy may be full.
- 5. This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.
- 6. If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth:
- 7. But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all Sin.
- 8. If we say that we have **no sin**, we **deceive ourselves**, and **the truth is not in us**.
- 9. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- 10. If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

## 15. Examples of letting Satan Steal their Heart

These are examples of how NT Disciples allowed their hearts to be stolen by Satan.

- First, Satan entered Judas and caused him to betray JESUS CHRIST.
- Later in the Scriptures, Satan entered Ananias and Sapharia and convinced them to lie to the HOLY GHOST!
- We also see how the LOVE of MONEY becomes the root of all evil!





#### A. Satan filled Judas Heart

#### ST. LUKE 22:1-5

- 1. Now the feast of unleavened bread drew nigh, which is called the Passover.
- 2. And the chief priests and scribes sought how they might kill him; for they feared the people.
- 3. Then entered Satan into Judas surnamed Iscariot, being of the number of the twelve.
- 4. And he went his way, and communed with the chief priests and captains, how he might betray him unto them.
- 5. And they were glad, and covenanted to give him money.

#### B. Satan filled Ananias' Heart to lie to the Holy Ghost

#### **ACTS 5:1-11**

- 1. But a **certain man named Ananias**, with Sapphira his wife, sold a possession,
- 2. And kept back part of the price, his wife also being privy to it, and brought a certain part, and laid it, at the apostles' feet.
- 3. But Peter said, **Ananias**, why **hath Satan filled thine heart** to **lie** to the **Holy Ghost**, and to **keep back part of the price of the land**?
- 4. Whiles it remained, was it not thine own? and after it was sold, was it not in thine own power? why hast thou conceived this thing in thine heart? thou hast not lied unto men, but unto God.
- 5. And **Ananias hearing these words fell down**, and **gave up the ghost**: and great fear came on all them that heard these things.
- 6. And the young men arose, wound him up, and carried him out, and buried him.
- 7. And it was about the space of **three hours after, when his wife, not knowing what was done**, came in.
- 8. And Peter answered unto her, **Tell me whether ye sold the land for so much**? And she said, **Yea, for so much**.
- 9. Then Peter said unto her, **How is it that ye have agreed together** to **tempt the Spirit of the Lord**? behold, the feet of them which have buried thy husband are at the door, and shall carry thee out.
- 10. Then fell she down straightway at his feet, and yielded up the ghost: and the young men came in, and found her dead, and, carrying her forth, buried her by her husband.
- 11. And great fear came upon all the church, and upon as many as heard these things.

## C. The love of money is the root of all evil

The

#### 1 TIMOTHY 6:3-11

3. If any man teach otherwise, and consent not to wholesome words, even the words of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to the doctrine which is according to godliness;





- 4. He is proud, knowing nothing, but doting about questions and strifes of words, whereof cometh envy, strife, railings, evil surmisings,
- 5. Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself.
- 6. But godliness with contentment is great gain.
- 7. For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out.
- 8. And having food and raiment let us be therewith content.
- 9. But they that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and hurtful LUSTS, which drown men in DESTRUCTION and PERDITION.
- 10. For the **LOVE of MONEY is the ROOT of ALL EVIL**: which while some **COVETED** after, they have **ERRED** from the **FAITH**, and **PIERCED** themselves through with **MANY SORROWS**.
- 11. But thou, **O man of God**, **FLEE THESE THINGS**; and **FOLLOW** after **righteousness**, **godliness**, **faith**, **love**, **patience**, **meekness**.

#### D. Love not the world neither the things of the world

#### 1 JOHN 2:14-18

- 14. I have written unto you, fathers, because ye have known him that is from the beginning. I have written unto you, young men, because ye are strong, and the word of God abideth in you, and ye have overcome the wicked one.
- 15. Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.
- 16. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is NOT OF THE FATHER, but is OF THE WORLD.
- 17. And the world passeth away, and the LUST thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.
- 18. Little children, it is the last time: and as ye have heard that antichrist shall come, even now are there many antichrists; whereby we know that it is the last time.

#### E. Love God with all our hearts

We are commanded to LOVE GOD with all our HEARTS! Yet, Satan wants to steal GOD's LOVE from mankind, who is the crown of GOD's creation. (Heb. 2:6-12)

#### St. Matthew 22:35-40

- 35. Then one of them, which was a lawyer, asked him a question, tempting him, and saying,
- 36. Master, which is the great commandment in the law?
- 37. Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.
- 38. This is the **first and great commandment**.
- 39. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.
- 40. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.





## a. Deuteronomy 6:4 (OT)

The Jewish people were commanded to LOVE GOD with all their HEARTS in the OT!

#### **DEUTERONOMY 6:4-9**

- 4. Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD:
- 5. And thou shalt **love the LORD thy God** with all **thine heart**, and with all **thy soul**, and with all **thy might**.
- 6. And these words, which I command thee this day, SHALL BE IN THINE HEART:
- 7. And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.
- 8. And thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes.
- 9. And thou shalt write them upon the posts of thy house, and on thy gates.

#### b. St. Matthew 22:35-40

#### ST. MATTHEW 22:35-40

- 35. Then one of them, which was a lawyer, asked him a question, tempting him, and saying,
- 36. Master, which is the great commandment in the law?
- 37. Jesus said unto him, **Thou shalt love the Lord thy God** with **all thy HEART**, and with **all thy SOUL**, and with **all thy MIND**.
- 38. This is the first and great commandment.
- 39. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.
- 40. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

#### c. 10 Commandments

The Ten Commandments are fulfilled in Love. The **first four** (4) teach us "**HOW-TO**" **LOVE GOD**. The **last six** (6) teach us "**HOW-TO**" **LOVE each other**!

#### Romans 13:8-10

- 8. Owe no man any thing, but to love one another: for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law.
- 9. For this, Thou shalt **not commit adultery**, Thou **shalt not kill**, Thou **shalt not steal**, Thou **shalt not bear false witness**, Thou **shalt not covet**; and if there be **any other commandment**, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, **Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself**.
- 10. Love worketh no ill to his neighbour: therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.
  - d. The temple laws was the means of covering sins animal sacrifice until JESUS can to pay the price once and for all with his own blood





The OT tabernacle and temple were a place to provide sacrifices for the sins of the Jewish people until JESUS came as the Messiah to save them from all their sins. (*Gal. 3*)

#### e. Romans 13:8-10

#### **ROMANS 13:8-10**

- 8. Owe no man any thing, but to love one another: for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law.
- 9. For this, **Thou shalt not commit adultery**, Thou **shalt not kill**, Thou **shalt not steal**, Thou shalt not **bear false witness**, Thou **shalt not covet**; and if there **be any other commandment**, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, **Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself**.
- 10. Love worketh no ill to his neighbour: therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.

#### F. 1st church in Revelation had lost their first love

#### **REVELATION 2:1-7**

- 1. Unto the angel of the church of Ephesus write; These things saith he that holdeth the seven stars in his right hand, who walketh in the midst of the seven golden candlesticks;
- 2. **I know thy works**, and thy labour, and thy patience, and how thou canst not bear them which are evil: and thou hast tried them which say they are apostles, and are not, and hast found them liars:
- 3. And hast borne, and hast patience, and for my name's sake hast laboured, and hast not fainted.
- 4. Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee, because thou hast left thy first love.
- 5. Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent.
- 6. But this thou hast, that thou hatest the deeds of the Nicolaitanes, which I also hate.
- 7. **He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches**; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.
- G. Israel played the whore and went after other gods; the pagan gods of the surrounding nations (mythology gods were demonic forces - fallen angels)

#### a. Seven nations were removed from the Promised Land

The LORD destroyed seven nations and gave the Promised Land to the children of Israel.

#### **Deuteronomy 7:1-3**

1. When the LORD thy God shall bring thee into the land whither thou goest to possess it, and hath cast out many nations before thee, the Hittites, and the Girgashites, and the Amorites, and the Canaanites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites, seven nations greater and mightier than thou;





- 2. And when the LORD thy God shall deliver them before thee; thou shalt smite them, and utterly destroy them; thou shalt make no covenant with them, nor show mercy unto them:
- 3. Neither shalt thou make marriages with them; thy daughter thou shalt not give unto his son, nor his daughter shalt thou take unto thy son.

## H. Adultery and fornication are about loving others in this world instead of staying a chaste virgin prepared for a marriage to JESUS CHRIST

### I. We should anticipate the travel to Heaven

Disciples need to focus on and prepare for the LORD's return.

#### 1 Thessalonians 4:1-7; 14-18

- 1. Furthermore then we beseech you, brethren, and **exhort you by the Lord Jesus**, that as ye have received of us how ye ought to walk and to please God, so ye would abound more and more.
- 2. For ye know what commandments we gave you by the Lord Jesus.
- 3. For this is the will of God, even your sanctification, that ye should abstain from fornication:
- 4. That every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and honour;
- 5. **Not in the lust of concupiscence**, even as the Gentiles which know not God:
- 6. That no man go beyond and **defraud his brother in any matter**: because that the Lord is the avenger of all such, as we also have forewarned you and testified.
- 7. For God hath not called us unto uncleanness, but unto holiness.
- 14. For **if we believe that Jesus died and rose again**, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.
- 15. For this we say unto you by the **word of the Lord**, that **we which are alive and remain unto** the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep.
- 16. For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:
- 17. Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.
- 18. Wherefore comfort one another with these words.

12. Blessed is the man that **endureth temptation**: for when he is tried, **he shall receive the crown of LIFE**, which the **Lord hath promised** to **them that LOVE HIM**.

#### **TITUS 1:13-16**

- 13. This witness is true. Wherefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the faith;
- 14. Not giving heed to Jewish fables, and commandments of men, that turn from the truth.





- 15. Unto the pure all things are pure: but unto them that are DEFILED and UNBELIEVING is nothing pure; but even their MIND and CONSCIENCE is DEFILED.
- 16. They profess that they know God; but in works they deny him, being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate.
