Foundation Reset (Expectation Set)



This is not about debating the merits of the Organized Christian Church

- I personally do not have an opinion for or against Organized Churches
 - They can be great and powerful in the Kingdom of GOD, If they make disciples and teach the
 NC Holy Scriptures in their entirety and in agreement with the Holy Spirit
 - However, they can be deceiving, seducing, and destructive to those they are leading if they
 replace the Holy Scriptures with their own philosophical, political, economic, social, or other
 doctrines

This is about awakening individuals to the NC Scriptural Commandments for them to become Disciples (G3101, 3101. mathetes, math-ay-tes'; from G3129; a learner, i.e. pupil:--disciple)

- JESUS says that those who will follow Him must "deny" themselves, take up their "cross" and "follow" Him (St. Matt. 16:24-26)
- Peter commanded newborn babes to desire (love, seek) the sincere milk of GOD's Word so they can grow (1 Pet. 2:1-2)



Focused on Your Growth



The <u>teachings provided in this conference</u> are to <u>teach</u> and <u>equip you</u> to <u>read</u>, <u>study</u>, and <u>meditate</u> on the Scriptures of the NC Covenant established in JESUS' blood that ye might be <u>washed</u> and <u>cleansed</u> by the WORD of GOD!  <u>Discipleship training materials</u> as resources for individuals and organizations

- Questions to equip Followers of JESUS to Pursue Discipleship
 - What is <u>It</u>? (You <u>MUST</u> READ the Holy Scriptures)
 - What does it Mean? (You MUST STUDY and HEAR the HOLY SPIRIT)
 - What does it <u>Look Like</u>?
 - Why is it <u>Important</u>? (You <u>MUST STUDY</u> the WORD)
 - How do I DO it? (You MUST RENEW the THOUGHTS of one's IMAGINATION)
 - How Do I <u>TEACH Others</u>? (You <u>MUST</u> be a Disciple and experience TRANSFORMATION before you can TEACH others.)

READING is the **BEGINNING** of One's Journey to **TRANSFORMATION!**



Commanded to TEACH



- JEUS sent His Disciples (Apostles with) a COMMANDMENT to TEACH and Make Disciples
 - Mat 28:16-17 (KJV) Then the eleven disciples went away into Galilee, into a mountain where JESUS had appointed them. 17 And when they saw HIM, they worshipped HIM: BUT some <u>DOUBTED</u>.
 - Mat 28:18-20 (KJV) And JESUS came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto ME in HEAVEN and in earth. 19 GO ye therefore, and TEACH all nations, baptizing them in the name of the FATHER, and of the SON, and of the HOLY GHOST: 20 TEACHING them to OBSERVE all things whatsoever I have COMMANDED you: and, Io, I AM with you alway, even unto the END of the world. Amen.



Commanded to TEACH



- JEUS sent His Disciples (Apostles with) a COMMANDMENT to TEACH and Make Disciples
- Apostle
 - apostolos, ap-os'-tol-os, G652 From G649; a delegate; specifically an ambassador of the Gospel; officially a commissioner of Christ ("apostle"), (with miraculous powers): apostle, messenger, he that is sent.

You BECOME a Disciples BEFORE You can MAKE a DISCIPLE!



Conference's Objectives




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2. Scriptural Highlight Colors & Meanings



Scriptural Highlight Colors & Meanings



- Purple (Royal) Royal Heavenly Nouns (Names of God, Jesus, Holy Ghost, Heaven, etc.)
- Blue (Royal, Dark) <u>Spiritual Truths & Commandments</u> (Covenant, Faith, Hope, Love, Repent, Sanctify, Walk, Thoughts, Imaginations, Heart, etc.)
- Orange Action Verbs (What Disciples are commanded to do or allow to be done in their lives i.e., hear, purge, confirm, continue, speak, build, partake, rejoice, give, etc.)
- Red <u>Forbidden Thoughts or Actions</u> (thoughts, sins, transgression, actions, behaviors that disciples should not permit in their thought life or their behaviors)
- Green <u>Earthly Nouns</u> (Names of disciples, saints, apostles, places, etc.)
- Pink Conditional Statement (A choice that results in a consequence, i.e., If/Then statements: "IF you continue in my words, THEN are ye my Disciples indeed.") (St. John 8:31)
- Yellow Highlighted (done for emphasis on select words like any, all, every, etc.)
- Blue (Light) <u>Adjectives</u> (words that modify/clarify spiritual commandments & truths)





This is the Bible APP that I used to color code the words when I am reading and studying the Holy Scriptures. I have the APP on my iPhone and Mac computers.






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e-Sword on iPhone


















3. Returning to the Original Meanings – Greek Definitions to Key Discipleship Words





- It is critical that Disciples know and use the <u>original definitions</u> of the words that God gave to the Apostle writers of the NC Scriptures
 - The Word of God is eternal and never changes (Psa. 119:89, 160; 1 Pet. 1:25; St. Mat. 24:35; St. Mark 13:31; St. Luke 21:33; 2 Tim. 3:16-17)
 - Scriptures are not open to private interpretations of individuals (2 Pet. 1:20-21)
 - Many translations have perverted the true meanings of the Words given by the Holy Ghost through the Apostles
 - The Greek language was chosen by God for the NC Writings
 - Greek language is one of the most expressive if not the most expressive languages in the world next to Hebrew
 - Many religious leaders have <u>exclude key discipleship words from their teachings</u>
 - Having the true definitions from the original language will enable disciples to truly understand and follow God's NC Commandments so they can walk upright and please Him



Original Meanings of GOD's WORDS!



- Hebrew (Old Covenant, OC) How the WORD was given to Israel
 - Yes, each character in the Hebrew alphabet carries a deeper meaning beyond just its phonetic sound, with many letters representing concepts like unity, creation, life, and divine presence, often explored in Jewish mysticism where the letters are seen as symbolic and imbued with spiritual significance; this is particularly evident in the first letter, "Aleph," which signifies the concept of oneness and the ultimate source of all things. (Google AI Hebrew Language Characters have a meaning)
- Greek (New Covenant, NC) each word has a specific meaning as it correlates between the Kingdom of Heaven and the OC
 - For example, the Holy Bible's OT only uses the word Covenant
 - However, the Holy Bible's NT often translates Covenant as Testament





Disciple

• 3101. mathetes, math-ay-tes'; from G3129; a learner, i.e. pupil:--disciple.

Repent

• 3340. <u>metanoeo</u>, met-an-o-eh'-o; from G3326 and G3539; <u>to think</u> <u>differently</u> or afterwards, i.e. <u>reconsider</u> (mor. feel compunction):--<u>repent</u>.

Sanctify

37. hagiazo, hag-ee-ad'-zo; from G40; to make holy, i.e. (cer.) purify or consecrate; (mentally) to venerate:--hallow, be holy, sanctify.

Sanctification

• 38. hagiasmos, hag-ee-as-mos'; from G37; prop. purification, i.e. (the state) purity; concr. (by Hebr.) a purifier:--holiness, sanctification.





Transformed

• 3339. metamorphoō, met-am-or-fo'-o, From G3326 and G3445; to transform (literally or figuratively "metamorphose"): - change, transfigure, transform.

Learn

3129. manthanō, man-than'-o, Prolonged from a primary verb, another form of which, μαθέω matheō, is used as an alternate in certain tenses; to learn (in any way): - learn, understand.

Grow

• 837. auxanō, owx-an'-o, A prolonged form of a primary verb; to grow ("wax"), that is, enlarge (literally or figuratively, actively or passively): - grow (up), (give the) increase.

Teach

• 3100. mathēteuō, math-ayt-yoo'-o, From G3101; intransitively to become a pupil; transitively to disciple, that is, enrol as scholar: - be disciple, instruct, teach.

 sacred (phys. pure, mor. blameless or religious, cer. consecrated):--(most) holy (one, thing), saint.

 - 458. anomia, an-om-ee'-ah; from G459; illegality, i.e. violation of law or (gen.) wickedness:--iniquity, X transgress (-ion of) the law, unrighteousness.

Following the Key NC Truths



- It is not so much about the word that we use today as it is to understand and do what was meant by the original words written by the Apostles in the NC that they proclaimed came directly from JESUS CHRIST by the HOLY GHOST
- TRANSFORMATION requires us to understand and execute (DO and KEEP) what was originally understood by those who JESUS CHRIST taught regarding how to FOLLOW HIM and be His TRUE Disciples!
- Whether we call ourselves Christians, Disciples, Believers, Followers, or whatever new word comes along, it will not matter if we do not UNDERSTAND the ORIGINAL MEANINGS and DO what the LORD INITIALLY COMMANDED!







4. The Creation was about GOD seeking a Wife for His SON!



The Marriage of JESUS CHRIST to His Bride FIRST seen in Genesis



- GOD prophetically <u>FIRST</u> spoke of the future marriage of JESUS to His Bride in the Garden
 - Gen 2:22-24 (KJV) And the rib, which the LORD GOD had taken from man, made HE a woman, and brought her unto the man. 23 And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man. 24 Therefore shall a man LEAVE his father and his mother, and shall CLEAVE unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.
 - Mat 19:4-6 (KJV) And HE answered and said unto them, Have ye NOT READ, that HE which made them at the beginning made them male and female, 5 And SAID, For this cause shall a man LEAVE father and mother, and shall CLEAVE to his wife: and they twain shall be one flesh? 6 Wherefore they are NO more twain, but one flesh. What therefore GOD hath joined together, let not man put asunder.




JESUS Came Looking for a Bride



- JESUS came looking for a bride among mankind to become his Wife
 - Eph 5:25-32 (KJV) Husbands, love your wives, even as CHRIST also loved the church, and gave HIMSELF for it; 26 That HE might SANCTIFY and cleanse it with the washing of water by the WORD, 27 That HE might present it to himself a glorious church, NOT having SPOT, or WRINKLE, or any such thing; but that it should be HOLY and WITHOUT BLEMISH. 28 So ought men to LOVE their wives as their own bodies. He that LOVETH his wife LOVETH himself. 29 For NO man ever yet hated his own flesh; but nourisheth and cherisheth it, even as the LORD the church: 30 For we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones. 31 For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh. 32 This is a GREAT MYSTERY: but I speak concerning CHRIST and the CHURCH.







5. What is the Kingdom of GOD– The Kingdom of Heaven?



Seek Ye First the Kingdom of Heaven



- JESUS Commands His Followers to Seek FIRST the KINGDOM of HEAVEN
 - Mat 6:31-34 (KJV) Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we <u>EAT</u>? or, What shall we <u>DRINK</u>? or, Wherewithal shall we be <u>CLOTHED</u>? 32 (For after <u>ALL</u> these things do the <u>Gentiles SEEK</u>:) for your <u>HEAVENLY FATHER</u> knoweth that ye have need of <u>ALL</u> these things. 33 But SEEK ye <u>first</u> the KINGDOM of GOD, and HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS; and <u>ALL</u> these things shall be added unto you. 34 Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day *is* the evil thereof.
- To SEEK the Kingdom of Heaven, we MUST FIRST Define it in the Scriptures



NC is about the Kingdom of Heaven



- John the Baptist's Message REPENT for the Kingdom of Heaven
 - Mat 3:1-2 (KJV) In those days came John the Baptist, preaching in the wilderness of Judaea, 2 And saying, <u>REPENT</u> ye: for the KINGDOM of HEAVEN is at hand.
- <u>JESUS's FIRST Message REPENT</u> for the Kingdom of Heaven is at Hand
 - Mat 4:17 (KJV) From that time JESUS began to PREACH, and to say, REPENT: for the KINGDOM of HEAVEN is at hand



JESUS' Kingdom is **NOT** of this World



- JESUS taught that His Kingdom was NOT of this WORLD
 - Jhn 18:33-35 (KJV) Then Pilate entered into the judgment hall again, and called JESUS, and said unto him, Art thou the King of the Jews? 34 JESUS answered him, Sayest thou this thing of thyself, or did others tell it thee of ME? 35 Pilate answered, Am I a Jew? Thine own nation and the chief priests have delivered thee unto me: what hast THOU done?
 - Jhn 18:36 (KJV) JESUS answered, MY <u>KINGDOM</u> is <u>NOT</u> of this WORLD: if MY <u>KINGDOM</u> were of this WORLD, then would MY servants fight, that I should <u>NOT</u> be DELIVERED to the Jews: but now is MY KINGDOM NOT from hence.



Abraham sought the Kingdom of GOD



- Abraham looked for a <u>COUNTRY</u> with a <u>CITY</u> with <u>FOUNDATIONS</u> that was <u>MADE</u> by <u>GOD</u>
 - Heb 11:8-10 (KJV) By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, OBEYED; and he went out, NOT knowing whither he went. 9 By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as in a STRANGE country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise: 10 For he looked for a CITY which hath FOUNDATIONS, whose BUILDER and MAKER is GOD.



OC Individuals of Faith Sought a Heavenly Country with a Holy City of GOD

- Those who lived by Faith in the OC were PILGRIMS and STRANGERS on EARTH because they were looking for a HEAVENLY COUNTRY with the CITY of GOD
 - Heb 11:13-16 (KJV) These all died in FAITH, NOT having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were STRANGERS and PILGRIMS on the EARTH. 14 For they that say such things declare plainly that they SEEK a COUNTRY. 15 And truly, if they had been MINDFUL of that COUNTRY from whence they CAME OUT, they might have had opportunity to have RETURNED. 16 But now they desire a better country, that is, an HEAVENLY: wherefore GOD is NOT ashamed to be called their GOD: for HE hath PREPARED for them a CITY.



JESUS went Away to Prepare a Place for Those who would FOLLOW Him



- JESUS went <u>AWAY</u> to <u>PREPARE</u> a PLACE for <u>US</u>
 - Jhn 14:1-6 (KJV) Let NOT your HEART be TROUBLED: ye believe in GOD, believe also in ME. 2 In my FATHER's house are many mansions: if it were NOT so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto MYSELF; that where I AM, there ye may be also. 4 And whither I go ye KNOW, and the WAY ye KNOW. 5 Thomas saith unto him, LORD, we KNOW NOT whither THOU goest; and how can we KNOW the WAY? 6 JESUS saith unto him, I am the WAY, the TRUTH, and the LIFE: NO man cometh unto the FATHER, but by ME.



The Bride, the New City, Holy Jerusalem



- John say the NEW CITY, HOLY JERUSALEM descending from the NEW HEAVEN to the NEW EARTH; described as the BRIDE for JESUS, the BRIDEGROOM
- GOD prepared a bride for His SON
 - Rev 21:1-3 (KJV) (1) And I saw a new HEAVEN and a new EARTH: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. (2) And I John saw the HOLY CITY, new JERUSALEM, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a BRIDE adorned for her husband. (3) And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the TABERNACLE of God is with men, and he will DWELL with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God.



John Shown the Holy City Jerusalem, the Lamb's Wife



- The Bride, the Lamb's WIFE
 - Rev 21:9-10 (KJV) (9) And there came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, I will shew thee the BRIDE, the LAMB'S WIFE. (10) And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that GREAT CITY, the HOLY JERUSALEM, descending out of heaven from God,
- The new city, great city, Holy Jerusalem, and synonymous with the BRIDE and WIFE of JESUS CHRIST




Apostles are the Foundations of the Holy City



- The Holy City has twelve (12) foundations containing the names of the Twelve Apostles of the Lamb
 - Rev 21:14 (14) And the wall of the city had twelve FOUNDATIONS, and in them the NAMES of the TWELVE APOSTLES of the LAMB.
- The NEW COVENANT (NC) is built on the COMMANDMENTS and LAWS JESUS gave to HIS Twelve Apostles
 - Act 1:1-2 (1) The former treatise have I made, O Theophilus, of all that JESUS began both to <u>DO</u> and <u>TEACH</u>, 2 UNTIL the day in which HE was <u>TAKEN UP</u>, AFTER that HE through the HOLY GHOST had given COMMANDMENTS unto the <u>APOSTLES</u> whom <u>HE had CHOSEN</u>:
- JESUS directly chose 13 Apostles, the original 12 plus Paul; Judas betrayed JESUS, leaving 12; the remaining 12 are in the foundation







6. We Must Repent to Enter the Kingdom of Heaven



Must Repent (Think Differently) to Enter the Kingdom of Heaven



- John the Baptist's Message Repent for the Kingdom of Heaven
 - Mat 3:1-2 (KJV) In those days came John the Baptist, preaching in the wilderness of Judaea, 2 And saying, <u>REPENT</u> ye: for the KINGDOM of HEAVEN is at hand.
- JESUS's Message Repent for the Kingdom of Heaven is at Hand
 - Mat 4:17 (KJV) From that time JESUS began to PREACH, and to say, REPENT: for the KINGDOM of HEAVEN is at hand



Transformation Required to Enter Heaven



- Disciples are cautioned to <u>NOT</u> be CONFORMED to this World, but to be TRANSFORMED by the RENEWING of their MIND
 - Rom 12:1-2 (KJV) I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of GOD, that ye PRESENT your bodies a living SACRIFICE, holy, acceptable unto GOD, which is your reasonable service. 2 And be NOT CONFORMED to this world: but be ye TRANSFORMED by the RENEWING of your MIND, that ye may prove what is that GOOD, and ACCEPTABLE, and PERFECT, WILL of GOD.




Disciples MUST not WALK in the Vanity of their Minds



- Disciples are called to LEARN the TRUTH and NOT WALK in the VANITY of THEIR MINDS
 - Eph 4:17-24 (KJV) This I say therefore, and testify in the LORD, that ye henceforth WALK NOT as other Gentiles WALK, in the vanity of their MIND, 18 Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the LIFE of GOD through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their HEART: 19 Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness. 20 But ye have NOT so LEARNED CHRIST; 21 If so be that ye have HEARD HIM, and HAVE BEEN TAUGHT by HIM, as the TRUTH is in JESUS: 22 That ye PUT OFF concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the DECEITFUL LUSTS; 23 And be RENEWED in the spirit of your MIND; 24 And that ye PUT ON the new man, which after GOD is CREATED in RIGHTEOUSNESS and TRUE HOLINESS.







7. The Mystery of Discipleship



The Mystery of Discipleship



- What is a Mystery?
 - Musterion (moos-tay'-ree-on) From a derivative of μύω muō (to shut the mouth); a secret or "mystery" (through the idea of silence imposed by initiation into religious rites): mystery.
- Why is Discipleship a Mystery
 - Constantine, the Roman Emperor, imposed the religion of Christianity on the World in 325 A.D. and sought to eliminate the Disciples and TRUE FOLLOWERS of CHRIST
 - St. Augustine formulated the teachings of Christianity using the philosophical techniques of Socrates, Plato, Aristotle, and the other Greek Philosophers.
 - The Roman Catholic (universal) Church forbade the laity to have the Scriptures.
 - The Catholic Church conducted their masses in Latin (an unspoken language)

The Scriptural Knowledge of "How-To" Be a TRUE Disciple of CHRIST was LOST!




How Do We Get Back to Being Disciples



- We MUST become Disciples, LEARNERS and PUPILS, of the NC Writings of the Apostles whom JESUS sent to publish his Commandments and Law to SANTIFCY and CLEANSE His Bride to be Holy and Glorious for His Coming Marriage
- The question then is How do we do that?
 - This conference is designed to answer the question and provide practical techniques, knowledge, and tools that you can use to become a LEARNER and PUPIL of JESUS CHRIST
 - NT Church Movement website has published numerous books, charts, diagrams, lessons, a syllabus, and other tools to equip you to be a student of the Holy Scriptures







8. What is Discipleship?



Discipleship is about becoming CHRIST's GALILEE Bride and the Lamb's WIFE in His Kingdom

- 1. Discipleship is the journey one FOLLOWS to become the Bride and Wife of JESUS CHRIST, the Lamb of GOD
- 2. A Disciple heeds the Call to FOLLOW JESUS CHRIST by FAITH,
- 3. A Disciple becomes a LEARNER through being a PUPIL (student) of the NC Writings of the Apostles so they can GROW
- 4. A Disciple GROWS by READING GOD's WORD, HEARING the HOLY SPIRIT, and KEEPING the COMMANDMENTS and LAWS of GOD to PLEASE Him
- 5. A Disciple SANCTIFIES and CLEANSES themselves by replacing the Evil THOUGHTS of their IMAGINATION, their HEART with GOOD THOUGHTS by RENEWING their MIND in GOD's WORD to be TRANSFORMED!

The HEART is the SUM of the THOUGHTS of One's IMAGINATION



What is Discipleship



- A TRUE Disciple is a LEARNER who is a PUPIL seeking to GROW in the WORD of GOD to be TRANSFORMED by REPENTING (thinking differently) through the RENEWING of their HEART (the sum of the THOUGHTS of their IMAGINATION) by READING and STUDYING the Holy Scriptures (the Holy Bible)
- This Scripture provides a summation of CHRIST's Purpose
 - Eph 5:25-27 (KJV) HUSBANDS, love your WIVES, even as CHRIST also loved the CHURCH, and gave HIMSELF for IT; 26 That HE might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the WORD, 27 That HE might present IT to HIMSELF a glorious CHURCH, NOT having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that IT should be holy and without blemish.



The Journey to Become the Lamb's Wife



- Discipleship is the process of being a PREPARED VIRGIN, awaiting the LORD's return
 - Mat 25:1-13 (KJV) Then shall the KINGDOM of HEAVEN be likened unto ten virgins, which took their lamps, and went forth to meet the bridegroom. 2
 And five of them were WISE, and five were FOOLISH. 3 They that were FOOLISH took their lamps, and took no oil with them: 4 But the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps. 5 While the BRIDEGROOM tarried, they all SLUMBERED and SLEPT. 6 And at midnight there was a cry made, Behold, the BRIDEGROOM cometh; go ye out to MEET HIM.



The Journey to Become the Lamb's Wife



- Discipleship is the process of being a <u>PREPARED VIRGIN</u>, awaiting the LORD's return
 - Mat 25:7-13 (KJV) 7 Then all those virgins arose, and trimmed their lamps. 8 And the FOOLISH said unto the WISE, Give us of your oil; for our lamps are GONE OUT. 9 But the WISE answered, saying, Not so; lest there be NOT ENOUGH for us and you: but go ye rather to them that sell, and buy for yourselves. 10 And while they went to buy, the BRIDEGROOM CAME; and they that were READY went in with HIM to the MARRIAGE: and the door was shut. 11 Afterward came also the other virgins, saying, LORD, LORD, open to us. 12 But HE answered and said, Verily I say unto you, I KNOW YOU NOT. 13 WATCH therefore, for ye KNOW NEITHER the day NOR the hour wherein the SON of MAN COMETH.



JESUS Called Individuals to Follow Him



- JESUS did <u>NOT</u> ask anyone to <u>ACCEPT</u> Him!
 - There are <u>NO</u> Scriptural writings that teach or define what it looks like to ACCEPT JESUS CHRIST.
 - How to <u>ACCEPT</u> JESUS is taught from a philosophical perspective
- JESUS called individuals to FOLLOW Him!
 - JESUS called individuals to <u>FOLLOW</u> HIM (*Peter and Andrew, James and John, Paul, etc.*)
 - Discipleship is the process of an individual <u>becoming</u> a <u>Disciple</u> by <u>DOING</u> (<u>KEEPING</u>) the COMMANDMENTS and LAWS JESUS <u>SENT</u> to His Bride by the HOLY GHOST through the <u>Apostles</u> whom He had <u>CHOSEN</u>! (Acts 1:1-2)



How Do We Grow?



- FIRST, one MUST be BORN AGAIN to see the Kingdom of Heaven
 - Jhn 3:3 (KJV) JESUS answered and said unto him, Verily, Verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he <u>CANNOT</u> see the Kingdom of GOD.
- NEXT, one MUST READ the WORD of GOD to GROW
 - 1Pe 2:1-2 (KJV) Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings, 2 As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the WORD, that ye may GROW thereby:
 - Mat 4:4 (KJV) But HE answered and said, IT IS WRITTEN, Man <u>SHALL NOT live by bread alone</u>, but by every WORD that proceedeth out of the mouth of GOD.



Being Transformed is Essential



- JESUS gave Paul a commandment that Disciples MUST be Transformed
 - Rom 12:1-2 (KJV) I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of GOD, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto GOD, which is your reasonable service. 2 And be NOT conformed to this world: but be ye TRANSFORMED by the RENEWING of your MIND, that ye may PROVE what is that GOOD, and ACCEPTABLE, and PERFECT, WILL of GOD.
- Disciples must renew the THOUGHTS of their MINDS (Their HEARTS)
 - Eph 4:17-18 (KJV) This I say therefore, and testify in the LORD, that
 ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their
 mind, 18 Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from
 the life of GOD through the ignorance that is in them, because of
 the blindness of their heart:



JESUS' WORDS Makes True Disciples



- Continuing in JESUS' Words makes us True Disciples of CHRIST (St. John 8:30-32)
 - Jhn 8:30-32 (KJV) As HE spake these WORDS, many BELIEVED on HIM. 31 Then said JESUS to those Jews which BELIEVED on HIM, IF ye CONTINUE in MY WORD, THEN are ye MY DISCIPLES INDEED; 32 And ye SHALL KNOW the TRUTH, and the TRUTH SHALL MAKE you FREE.



Discipleship Practices Self-Examination



- Disciples are suppose to practice self-examination and self-control
 - 1Co 11:28-29 (KJV) But let a man <u>EXAMINE HIMSELF</u>, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup. 29 For he that eateth and drinketh <u>UNWORITHLY</u>, eateth and drinketh <u>DAMNATION</u> to himself, <u>NOT</u> discerning the LORD'S BODY.
 - 2Co 13:5 (KJV) <u>EXAMINE YOURSELVES</u>, whether ye be in the <u>FAITH</u>; <u>PROVE</u> your own selves. <u>KNOW</u> ye <u>NOT</u> your own selves, how that JESUS CHRIST is in you, EXCEPT ye be REPROBATES?
 - 1Co 9:27 (KJV) But I keep under my body, and bring it into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a CASTAWA7.



Religion Looks Outward; Discipleship Looks Inwards

- Religion focuses OUTWARDLY, while DISCIPLESHIP focuses INWARDLY
 - Religion focuses outwardly on the observable behaviors of others and tends to tell people what to do (a spirit of judgment)
 - Discipleship focuses inwardly on the IMAGINATIONS and THOUGHTS of one's own HEART (replacing evil with GOOD)
- Discipleship focuses on changing one's THOUGHTS and IMAGINATIONS through the <u>RENEWING</u> of their MIND in GOD's WORD, so they can prove that <u>GOOD</u>, ACCEPTABLE, and PERFECT WILL of GOD

Religion JUDGES others; Discipleship JUDGES oneself!



Discipleship Takeaways



- Understand that individuals who <u>repent</u> and are <u>BORN AGAIN</u> of the <u>WATER</u> and the <u>SPIRIT</u> are the <u>Church</u>, the <u>living body of JESUS</u>, <u>His Disciples</u>
- 2. Understand that the Holy Scriptures never looks or speaks to the Church as a religious organization (NOTE: This can distort one's understanding of what it means to be a Disciple and Follower of JESUS CHRIST)
 - 1. The Organized Modern Christian Church was brought into existence by the Roman Government
 - 2. It is based on the philosophical thoughts of the ancient world and it mixes those with Christian views and the Roman Culture
- 3. Understand that <u>WE</u> are to FOCUS on <u>being BORN AGAIN</u>, <u>being led by the Holy SPIRIT</u>, and were <u>called to be STUDENTS of the Holy Scriptures</u>







9. JESUS came to Cleanse His Bride so She could become His Wife



JESUS Came to Cleanse His Bride



JESUS sent the Word to Wash and Cleanse His Bride, the Church (the Ekklessia) (Eph. 5:25-27)

- Husbands, <u>love</u> your wives, even as
- [WHO] CHRIST also loved the church, and
- [WHAT] gave Himself for it;
- [WHY] That He might sanctify and cleanse it
- [HOW] with the <u>washing</u> of <u>water</u> by the WORD,
- [WHEN & WHERE] That He might <u>present</u> it to Himself a <u>glorious</u> church,
- [What does it look like] not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.



JESUS' Came to Clean His Bride (Con't)



JESUS sent the Word to Wash and Cleanse His Bride, the Church (the Ekklessia) (Eph. 5:25-27)

However, Those who do not wash in the WORD are "Dirty Babies" who will GROW UP to be "Filthy Brides" unprepared for the LORD's return!



JESUS Cleanses with His WORD



- JESUS cleanses disciples through His Word (St. John 15:1-7)
 - 1. I am the TRUE VINE, and MY FATHER is the HUSBANDMAN.
 - 2. Every branch in ME that beareth not fruit HE taketh away: and every branch that beareth fruit, HE PURGETH it, that it may bring forth more fruit.
 - 3. Now ye are CLEAN through the WORD which I have SPOKEN unto you.
 - 4. ABIDE in ME, and I in you. As the branch <u>CANNOT bear</u> fruit of itself, <u>EXCEPT</u> it <u>ABIDE</u> in the VINE; <u>NO</u> more can ye, <u>except</u> ye abide in ME.
 - 5. I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in ME, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for WITHOUT ME ye can do NOTHING.
 - 6. If a man abide NOT in ME, he is cast forth as a branch, and is WITHERED; and men gather them, and CAST them into the FIRE, and they are BURNED.
 - 7. If ye ABIDE in ME, and MY WORDS ABIDE in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.
 - 8. Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples.



David Explains How to Clean One's Heart



- <u>David requested GOD create in him a clean heart</u> and to renew a right spirit in him (Psa. 51:10)
 - 10.Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.
- The LORD helped David to understand that it was his responsibility to cleanse himself through the WORD of GOD (Psa. 119:9-11)
 - 9. BETH. Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? by taking heed thereto according to thy word.
 - 10.With my whole <u>heart</u> have I <u>sought</u> thee: O let me <u>not</u> wander from thy <u>commandments</u>.
 - 11. Thy word have I hid in mine heart (thoughts), that I might not sin against thee.



How the WORD Cleanses one's Thoughts



- Words cleans by examining the thoughts and intents of one's heart (Heb. 4:10-14)
 - 10. For he that is <u>entered</u> into <u>his rest</u>, he also <u>hath ceased</u> from his own works, as God did from <u>his</u>.
 - 11. Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief.
 - 12. For the word of God is <u>quick</u>, and <u>powerful</u>, and <u>sharper</u> than <u>any</u> twoedged sword, piercing even to the <u>dividing asunder</u> of <u>soul</u> and <u>spirit</u>, and of the <u>joints</u> and <u>marrow</u>, and is a <u>discerner</u> of the <u>thoughts</u> and <u>intents</u> of the <u>heart</u>.
 - 13. Neither is there any creature that is not manifest in his sight: but all things are naked and opened unto the eyes of him with whom we have to do.



How the Word Cleanses One's Heart



- Words cleans by serving as a mirror to reveal what is in one's heart (thoughts) (Jam. 1:22-25)
 - 21. Wherefore lay apart all <u>filthiness</u> and <u>superfluity</u> of <u>naughtiness</u>, and <u>receive</u> with meekness the <u>engrafted word</u>, which is able to <u>save</u> your <u>souls</u>.
 - 22. But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.
 - 23. For if any be a <u>hearer</u> of <u>the word</u>, and <u>not</u> a <u>doer</u>, he is like unto a man <u>beholding</u> his natural face in <u>a glass</u>:
 - 24. For he <u>beholdeth</u> himself, and goeth his way, and straightway <u>forgetteth</u> what manner of man he was.
 - 25. But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.




How the Word Brings About Transformation



- Reading cleanses and renews our mind which brings about transformation (Rom. 12:1-2)
 - 1. I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.
 - 2. And be <u>not conformed</u> to <u>this world</u>: but be ye <u>transformed</u> by the <u>renewing</u> of your mind, that ye <u>may prove</u> what is that <u>GOOD</u>, and acceptable, and <u>perfect</u>, will of God.







10. Key Truths of Discipleship



Called to Learn



- JESUS Called His Followers to Learn of Him
 - Mat 11:28-30 (KJV) Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take my yoke upon you, and <u>LEARN</u> of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.
 - Php 4:11 (KJV) <u>NOT</u> that I speak in respect of want: for I have <u>LEARNED</u>, in whatsoever state I am, therewith to be <u>CONTENT</u>.
 - Php 4:9 (KJV) Those things, which ye have both <u>LEARNED</u>, and <u>RECEIVED</u>, and <u>HEARD</u>, and <u>SEEN</u> in me, <u>DO</u>: and the GOD of peace shall be with you.
 - 2Ti 3:14 (KJV) But continue thou in the things which thou hast <u>LEARNED</u> and hast been assured of, knowing of whom thou hast <u>LEARNED</u> them;



Hunger for Him



- He that hungereth after righteous, shall be filled
 - Mat 5:6 (KJV) Blessed are they which do <u>HUNGER</u> and <u>THIRST</u> after righteousness: for they shall be filled.
 - Jhn 6:27 (KJV) Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that
 meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall
 give unto you: for him hath God the Father sealed.
 - Jhn 6:51 (KJV) I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.
 - Mat 4:4 (KJV) But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.







11. The LORD Charged us to READ the Apostles' Writings to All the Holy Brethren!



Disciples were Commanded to Read



- JESUS COMMANDED us to READ through Paul (1 Thess. 5:27)
 - 27. I CHARGE you by the LORD that this EPISTLE be READ unto all the holy brethren.
- Paul commanded that all Disciples needed to read all letters (Col. 4:16)
 - 16. And when this <u>EPISTLE</u> is <u>READ</u> among <u>you</u>, cause that it be <u>READ</u> also in the <u>church</u> of the <u>Laodiceans</u>; and that ye likewise <u>READ</u> the <u>EPISTLE</u> from <u>Laodicea</u>.
- Paul's expectation was that they had read previous letters (Eph. 3:3-4)
 - 3. How that by <u>revelation</u> he <u>made known</u> unto me [Paul] <u>the MYSTERY</u>; (as I wrote afore in few words,
 - 4. Whereby, when ye READ, ye may <u>understand</u> my <u>knowledge</u> in <u>the mystery</u> of Christ)



Disciples were commanded to Read



- Paul commands that we are to give attendance to reading (1 Tim. 4:13-16)
 - 13.Till I come, give attendance to READING, to exhortation, to doctrine.
 - 14. Neglect NOT the gift that is in thee, which was given thee by prophecy, with the laying on of the hands of the presbytery.
 - 15. Meditate upon these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all.
 - 16. Take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine; continue in them: for in doing this thou shalt both save thyself, and them that hear thee.



JESUS Commanded Disciples to READ



- JESUS, through John, commanded the READING of Revelation (Rev. 1:1-4)
 - 1. The Revelation of JESUS CHRIST, which GOD gave unto HIM, to show unto HIS servants things which must shortly come to pass; and HE sent and signified it by HIS angel unto HIS servant John:
 - 2. Who bare record of the WORD of GOD, and of the TESTIMONY of JESUS CHRIST, and of all things that he SAW.
 - 3. Blessed is he that READETH, and they that HEAR the WORDS of this PROPHECY, and KEEP those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand.
 - 4. John to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace be unto you, and peace, from HIM WHICH IS, and WHICH WAS, and WHICH IS TO COME; and from the seven SPIRITS which are before HIS THRONE;



Have we met the Commandment to Read?



- The elders in the Body of JESUS CHRIST were charged to READ the letters of His Apostles to the Holy Brethern
 - Have we READ to the Holy Brethern?
 - Have we encouraged them to READ?
 - Have we taught New Born Babes in CHRIST to READ
- We have many Babes, which explains the current state of the Organized Church



Babes in the Body of CHRIST



- Those who are UNSKILLFUL in GOD's WORD are Babes
- The first step is to be Born Again
 - Jhn 3:3 (KJV) Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, Verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.
- Next step is to desire the Milk of the WORD to Grow!
 - 1Pe 2:2 (KJV) As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby:




Babes in the Body of CHRIST



- We are Babes if we are unskillful in the WORD
 - Heb 5:12-13 (KJV) For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat. 13 For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe.
- Babes cause division and strife in the LORD's Body
 - 1Co 3:1-3 (KJV) And I, brethren, could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but as unto carnal, even as unto babes in Christ. 2 I have fed you with milk, and not with meat: for hitherto ye were not able to bear it, neither yet now are ye able. 3 For ye are yet carnal: for whereas there is among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men?







12. Wisdom Definition of the Church and Bride of JESUS CHRIST



Importance of the Scriptural Definition of Church



- Individuals <u>MUST</u> <u>UNDERSTAND</u> the Scriptural definition and meaning of the WORD "Church," or ONE could <u>easily be deceived</u> into spending time on activities that do <u>NOT</u> allow them to fulfill their purpose or GOD's <u>WILL</u> for their lives!
 - Most individuals perceive "the Church" as a building, an organization, or an institution
 - Most individuals do not understand or live as the Ekklesia which is defined in Scriptures as the Bride and future wife of the Lamb (JESUS CHRIST)



Scriptural Definition of the Church



- Scriptural Definitions of the Church, the Bride (Ekklesia)
 - Act 2:42-47 (KJV) And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers. 43 And fear came upon every soul: and many wonders and signs were done by the apostles. 44 And all that believed were together, and had all things common; 45 And sold their possessions and goods, and parted them to all men, as every man had need. 46 And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart, 47 Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.



Scriptural Definition of the Church



- Scriptural Definitions of the Church, the Bride (Ekklesia)
 - 1Co 12:28 (KJV) And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues.
 - Eph 5:25-27 (KJV) Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; 26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, 27 That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.



Two Definition of the Church for Discussion Purposes



"Why two definitions of CHURCH is used in this conference and my book? — because the Ekklesia (the Greek word used in the NC for Church) is Scripturally defined as the Body of JESUS CHRIST and it is GOOD if it follows CHRIST's will! (See page 411 in book, "Paul, The Moses of the New Testament Church")

- NT (NC) Church is when men follow the Scriptural Patterns that define the Church as recorded in the Book of Acts and throughout the NC Apostles' writings (27 books). The NC Church consists of all the DISCIPLES who are the living stones, the Bride of JESUS CHRIST, that was birthed by the HOLY GHOST on the Day of Pentecost
- 2. Organized Church (also Institutional, Christian, Religious, etc.) is when men replace the Holy Scriptures and the interpretations given by the Holy Spirit (the Holy Ghost) with their own system of beliefs, traditions, and dogma.







13. The Scriptures Teach Us "How-To" Accurately Define the HEART!



Scriptural Definition of the Heart



- It is critical that a Disciple define the heart based on Scriptures
 - Many individuals think the heart is where they based their decisions on emotional and learned behavior
 - However the Scriptures provide us a true definition of what constitutes the Heart
 - Understanding what the heart will guide individuals to know "How-To" please GOD;
 - Disciples were given the commandment to love the LORD our GOD with all heart
 - It is hard if not impossible to love GOD with all our heart if we lack the clearest scriptural understanding



Heart is Defined in Genesis



- GOD's gives the <u>best explanation of the hear</u>t whey he explained why he destroyed the earth during the days of Noah (Gen. 6:5-6)
 - 5. And God saw that the wickedness (iniquity) of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.
 - 6. And it repented the LORD that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart.
 - This OT Scripture reveals that the thoughts of a individual's imagination is defined by GOD as their heart
 - GOD destroyed mankind because their heart (the thoughts of their imagination) were perpetually evil (every, only, and continually)

What does your thought life look like? GOD see's every thought!



Deeper Look at the Heart in Genesis



Genesis 6:5-9 provides the best definition of the Heart in the Scriptures

- 5. And God saw that the <u>wickedness</u> of man was great in the earth, and that every <u>imagination</u> of the <u>thoughts</u> of his <u>heart</u> was <u>only</u> <u>evil</u> <u>continually</u>.
- 6. And it repented the LORD that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart.
- 7. And the LORD said, I will <u>destroy</u> man whom I have <u>created</u> from the face of the <u>earth</u>; both man, and <u>beast</u>, and the <u>creeping</u> thing, and the <u>fowls</u> of the <u>air</u>; for it <u>repenteth</u> me that I have <u>made</u> them.
- 8. But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.
- 9. These are the generations of <u>Noah</u>: <u>Noah</u> was a <u>just</u> man and <u>perfect</u> in his generations, and <u>Noah</u> <u>walked</u> with God.

Man's heart in Scriptures = the **Sum** of the **thoughts** of **his imagination**



OC Look at the Heart



- Proverb agrees that the thoughts are the heart (Prov. 23:7)
 - 7. For as he <u>thinketh</u> in his <u>heart</u> (thoughts), so <u>is</u> he: Eat and drink, saith he to thee; but his <u>heart</u> is not with thee.
- Heart (our thoughts) are desperately wickedness, but GOD knows (Jer. 17:9-10)
 - 9. The heart (thoughts) is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?
 - 10. I the LORD search the heart (thoughts), I try the reins, even to give every man according to his ways, and according to the fruit of his doings.



JESUS Explains Vain Worship



- Jesus explains vain worship (St. Matt. 15:7-9)
 - 7. Ye hypocrites, well did Esaias prophesy of you, saying,
 - 8. This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their heart (thoughts) is far from me.
 - 9. But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.



JESUS Explains the Heart



- JESUS explains that evil thoughts are what defiles an Individual (St. Matt. 15:17-20)
 - 17.Do not ye yet understand, that whatsoever entereth in at the mouth goeth into the belly, and is cast out into the draught?
 - 18.But those things which proceed out of the mouth come forth from the heart; and they defile the man.
 - 19.For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies:
 - 20. These are the things which defile a man: but to eat with unwashen hands defileth not a man.



Evil Thoughts of our Heart Defile the Temple of our Body



- Paul teaches the Holy Ghost will not dwell in a defiled temple (the body of an individual who has professed JESUS Christ) (1 Cor. 3:16-18)
 - 16.Know <u>ye</u> not that <u>ye</u> are the <u>temple</u> of God, and that the <u>Spirit</u> of God <u>dwelleth</u> in <u>you</u>?
 - 17.If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which temple ye are.
 - 18.Let no man <u>deceive</u> himself. If any man among you seemeth to be <u>wise</u> in this world, let him become <u>a fool</u>, that he may be <u>wise</u>.







14. Recovering the Definition and Meaning of Discipleship



Wisdom Definition of Discipleship



 Sharing the definition that the HOLY SPIRIT gave me of Discipleship so we can learn "How-To" become a TRUE DISCIPLE



Pursuit of Discipleship



- WISDOM: If we take away everything that we have tried that has <u>NOT</u> worked, what remains to be tried?
 - Most individuals have tried every aspect of the Christian Religion, but the one thing the New Covenant (NC) (in lieu of New Testament, NT) requires – The READING and STUDYING of the Holy Scriptures
 - Mat 22:29 (KJV) Jesus answered and said unto them, Ye do <u>ERR</u>, <u>NOT</u> knowing the scriptures, <u>NOR</u> the power of GOD.
 - Jhn 6:65-69 (KJV) And he said, Therefore said I unto you, that NO man can come unto me, except it were given unto him of my Father. 66 From that time many of his disciples went back, and WALKED NO more with HIM. 67 Then said JESUS unto the twelve, Will ye also go away? 68 Then Simon Peter answered HIM, Lord, to whom shall we go? THOU hast the WORDS of ETERNAL LIFE. 69 And we believe and are sure that THOU art that CHRIST, the SON of the living GOD.







15. Satan's Focus is to Steal GOD's WORD so He can Kill and Destroy You



Satan wants to Steal GOD's WORD



- Focus on Satan's Steal of the WORD in the parable of the Sower and The Seed
 - Mrk 4:13-17 (KJV) And he said unto them, KNOW ye NOT this parable? and how then will ye KNOW all parables? 14 The sower SOWETH the WORD. 15 And these are they by the WAY SIDE, where the WORD is SOWN; but when they have HEARD, Satan cometh immediately, and TAKETH AWAY the WORD that was **SOWN** in their **HEARTS**. 16 And these are they likewise which are SOWN on STONY GROUND; who, when they have HEARD the WORD, immediately RECEIVE IT with gladness; 17 And have NO ROOT in themselves, and so endure but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution ariseth for the WORD's sake, immediately they are offended.



Satan wants to Steal GOD's WORD



- JESUS' Description of the Devil and His Purpose
 - Jhn 10:10 (KJV) The THIEF cometh NOT, but for to STEAL, and to KILL, and to DESTROY: I am come that they might have LIFE, and that they might have IT more abundantly.
- The Devil is a Liar and the Father of ALL those who Lie
 - Jhn 8:43-47 (KJV) Why do ye NOT understand MY speech? even because ye CANNOT HEAR MY WORD. 44 Ye are of your FATHER the DEVIL, and the LUSTS of your FATHER ye will do. HE was a MURDERER from the beginning, and abode NOT in the TRUTH, because there is NO TRUTH in him. When HE speaketh a LIE, HE speaketh of his own: for HE is a LIAR, and the FATHER of IT. 45 And because I tell you the TRUTH, ye believe ME NOT. 46 Which of you convinceth ME of SIN? And if I say the TRUTH, why do ye NOT believe ME? 47 He that is of GOD HEARETH GOD'S WORDS: ye therefore HEAR them NOT, because ye are NOT of GOD.



Examples of Satan Stealing GOD's WORD



- Examples of Satan Stealing GOD'S WORDS (GOD's WORDS are His Commandments and Laws to govern our lives)
 - Adam-Eve Ate fruit from forbidden tree DIED (Gen. 2:16-17, 3:1-8)
 - Esau-Jacob Birthright sold over hunger LOST BIRTHRIGHT (Gen. 25:29-34)
 - Saul disobedient sacrifice rejected by GOD (1 Sam. 15:1-35)
 - 1Sa 15:26 (KJV) And Samuel said unto Saul, I will not return with thee: for thou hast rejected the WORD of the LORD, and the LORD hath rejected thee from being king over Israel.
 - Lot's Wife Turned back became a pillar of salt (Gen. 19:23-29)
 - Gen 19:26 (KJV) But his wife looked back from behind him, and she became a pillar of salt.

Origins of the Modern Christian Religion



The Establishment of Modern Christian Religion and Church after JESUS died was difficult for the following three (3) main reasons based on this article.

(Quoted from the University of Wyoming (UW) Religion Today: How Constantine Created the Christian Church, February 4, 2015)

- 1. "First, travel and communication were difficult at that time"
- 2. "Second, there was little agreement about Christianity's beliefs and teachings, the nature of Jesus and God, what writings were sacred, or even how to worship."
- 3. "Third, imperial persecutions of Christians happened every few decades."
 - a) "These drove Christianity underground and caused many Christians to turn away."
 - b) "But almost worse were the rifts that appeared afterward between Christians who kept the faith and those who APOSTATIZED to SAVE their LIVES, both of whom STILL CONSIDERED THEMSELVES CHRISTIANS."

Origins of the Modern Christian Church



Constantine I established the Modern Christian Church

- 1. "But if the founding of the church is defined as the first body of CHRISTIAN
 LEADERS who could determine accurate Christian belief and establish with sound authority their DEFINITION of CHRISTIANITY across the Mediterranean world, then the SINGLE MAN MOST responsible for that achievement was Constantine I, the emperor of Rome. "
- "Although the CREATION and ORGANIZATION of the CHURCH was <u>clearly a</u> process that took place over several decades, the <u>founding event</u> was the <u>Council of Nicea in 325 A.D.</u>"

The Religion of Christianity is Built on Philosophy instead of the WORD of GOD



Origins of the Modern Christian Church



Constantine I made Christianity a <u>LEGAL</u> religion

- 1. "Constantine appeared on the scene in the midst of the so-called Great Persecution, begun in 303 A.D., under Emperor Diocletian"
- 2. "By 305 A.D., the problems caused by the persecution were overtaken by those of determining Diocletian's successor"
- 3. "More than six different generals would fight to become the emperor.

 Constantine stood out because he became a Christian and unabashedly made Jesus the patron of his army. By 313 A.D., just two contenders remained, Constantine and Licinius"
- 4. "The two jointly issued the Edict of Milan, which made CHRISTIANITY a LEGAL RELIGION and officially ended the persecution"
- 5. "But, it was not until 324 A.D. that Constantine finally became the sole ruler of the Roman Empire"

Philosophy is the Study of Ideas



 Philosophy is the systematic study of ideas, a reasoned pursuit of fundamental truths, a quest for a comprehensive understanding of the world, a study of principles of conduct

- Herod asked JESUS, "What is Truth" (Philosophical question)
 - Jhn 18:37-38 (KJV) Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Jesus answered, Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the TRUTH HEARETH my voice. 38 Pilate saith unto him, What is TRUTH? And when he had said this, he went out again unto the Jews, and saith unto them, I find in him no fault at all.



Saint Augustine, Philosophical Father of the Modern Christian Church



Augustine was Born: November 13, 354 A.D. / Died: August 28, 430 A.D.

- 1. He adapted CLASSICAL THOUGHT to CHRISTIAN TEACHING and created a POWERFUL THEOLOGICAL SYSTEM of LASTING INFLUENCE
- 2. He also shaped the PRACTICE of BIBLICAL EXEGESIS and helped lay the foundation for much of medieval and MODERN CHRISTIAN THOUGHT
- 3. In Roman Catholicism he is formally recognized as a doctor of the church
- 4. More than five million words of his writings survive
- 5. Most INFLUENTIAL adaptation of the ANCIENT PLATONIC TRADITION with CHRISTIAN IDEAS that EVER OCCURRED in the LATIN CHRISTIAN WORLD
- 6. His particular **SYNTHESIS** of **CHRISTIAN**, **ROMAN**, and **PLATONIC TRADITIONS** defined the <u>terms</u> for much later **TRADITION** and **DEBATE**.

Platonic Traditions (from the Greeks)



The term "Platonism" is so widely used in modern scholarship that it is difficult to determine its meaning precisely as applicable either to a particular group of thinkers or to a specific COLLECTION of DOCTRINES. Ancient sources frequently describe "PLATONISTS" as those PHILOSOPHERS who further developed the known or presumed teaching of PLATO HIMSELF and "ACADEMICS" as those who pursued the SKEPTICAL METHODOLOGY believed to have been INITIATED by the **SOCRATES of PLATO's EARLIER DIALOGUES**. However, the substantive "Platonism" seems first to occur in scholarly literature only around the beginning of the eighteenth century when it was used to characterize **DOCTRINES** that were **NOT ONLY DERRIVED** from but also **COMBINED WITH PLATO'S OWN TEACHINGS by later EXEGETES.**

Christianity Forbade the Laity to Read



- 1. <u>Decree of the Council of Toulouse (1229 C.E.)</u>: "We <u>prohibit</u> also that the laity should be permitted to have the books of the Old or New Testament; but we <u>most strictly forbid</u> their <u>having any translation</u> of these books."
- 2. Ruling of the Council of Tarragona of 1234 C.E: "No one may possess the books of the Old and New Testaments in the Romance language, and if anyone possesses them he must turn them over to the local bishop within eight days after promulgation of this decree, so that they may be burned..."



Christianity Forbade the Laity to Read



- 3. Proclamations at the Ecumenical Council of Constance in 1415 C.E.: Oxford professor, and theologian John Wycliffe, was the first (1380 C.E.) to translate the New Testament into English to "...helpeth Christian men to study the Gospel in that tongue in which they know best Christ's sentence." For this "heresy" Wycliffe was posthumously condemned by Arundel, the archbishop of Canterbury. By the Council's decree "Wycliffe's bones were exhumed and publicly burned and the ashes were thrown into the Swift River."
- 4. Fate of William Tyndale in 1536 C.E.: William Tyndale was burned at the stake for translating the Bible into English. According to Tyndale, the Church forbid owning or reading the Bible to control and restrict the teachings and to enhance their own power and importance.

Paul Warns Against Philosophy



- Paul warns disciples to be beware of being spoiled through philosophy and vain deceit after the traditions of men and not after CHRIST
 - Col 2:8-9 (KJV) Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. 9 For in HIM dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.

Disciples are to DWELL in the WORD which is CHRIST!



Barriers to Transformation



EXPERTS

 Many have been treating religious leaders as EXPERTS in the same manner that those in the OC had to go to Priests in the Temple or Prophets (men and women of GOD) to receive a WORD!

AVOIDANCE

 There is reluctance, from the pupil's perspective, to have a discussion in regards to church doctrine; a hesitancy because questioning could be perceived as a personal attack instead of an attempt to obtain clarification on what is being read in the Holy Scriptures or perceived hypocrisy

CHRISTIANS versus DISCIPLES

- Most individuals are content being labeled as a Christian;
- They lack awareness or a desire to grow in the knowledge of the Scriptures



Experts is the function of Religion



- In the OC, individuals went to the Temple in Jerusalem to the priest they sought out the Prophets of GOD
- In the NC, the LORD wrote his laws on everyone's heart
 - Heb 8:11 (KJV) And they shall not teach every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord: for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest.
 - Heb 10:16 (KJV) This is the covenant that I will make with them
 after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts,
 and in their minds will I write them;

The Expert Syndrome is when we primarily seek religious experts instead of searching the Scriptures!




Rediscover the Holy Scriptures



- Living in the <u>END DAYS</u> since the <u>outpouring</u> of the HOLY GHOST on the Day of Pentecost
 - GOD poured out of His SPIRIT on all flesh in the LAST DAYS (Acts 2:16-21)
- FOCUSES on Disciples as the Church of JESUS CHRIST
 - Followers must become "STUDENTS" or "PUPILS" of the Holy Scriptures
 - Followers must seek to "BE LED BY THE HOLY SPIRIT"
 - Followers must understand that they "ARE the NC CHURCH and BRIDE of JESUS CHRIST"

Wisdom Questions to Guide Your Study?



- The LORD laid these wisdom questions in our hearts to share along with the actions disciples should be doing:
 - 1. What is written?
 - READ to know what GOD SAID (1 Pet. 2:2)
 - 2. What does it mean?
 - ASK their HEAVENLY FATHER and LISTEN to HEAR the HOLY SPIRIT who will reveal, "What does it mean?" (St. James 1:5-8; Rev. 2-3)
 - 3. What does it look like?
 - ASK the FATHER and LISTEN to HEAR the HOLY SPIRIT who will SHOW you
 what it looks like (St. John 16:12-13)
 - 4. How do I do it (keep it)?
 - CHANGE the THOUGHTS of their IMAGINATION, which will RENEW their minds and behavior (Changes WALK by replacing EVIL THOUGHTS with GOOD! (Rom. 12:1-2, Eph. 4:17-32)



Three (3) Steps to Transformation



- JESUS has John write the three (3) steps required to experience Transformation
 - Rev 1:3 (KJV) BLESSED is he that READETH, and they that HEAR the WORDS of this PROPHECY, and KEEP those things which are WRITTEN therein: for the time is at hand.
 - 1. READ = Disciples MUST begin to READ the WORD so they can KNOW "What is WRITTEN"
 - 2. HEAR = Disciples MUST have an EAR to HEAR what the HOLY SPIRIT is saying to the BRIDE (FOLLOWERS of JESUS CHRIST)
 - 3. KEEP = Disciples MUST become DOERS of the WORD of GOD so they can become SANCTIFIED (CLEANSED, HOLY)








18. JESUS Called Individuals to FOLLOW Him



JESUS Called Disciples to Follow Him



• The HOLY SPIRIT spoke to me that JESUS did NOT ask individuals to ACCEPT HIM — Apodechomai (ap-od-ekh'-om-ahee) From G575 and G1209; to take fully, that is, welcome (persons), approve (things): - accept, receive (gladly).






JESUS Called Disciples to Follow Him



• JESUS Called individuals to FOLLOW HIM – akoloutheo (ak-ol-oo-theh'-o) From G1 (as a particle of union) and κέλευθος keleuthos (a road); properly to be in the same way with, that is, to accompany (specifically as a disciple): - follow, reach.





JESUS Calls Individuals to Follow Him



- JESUS called individuals to FOLLOW Him (Peter & Andrew and James & John)
 - Mat 4:18-20 (KJV) And JESUS, WALKING by the sea of Galilee, saw two brethren, Simon CALLED Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea: for they were fishers. 19 And HE saith unto them, FOLLOW ME, and I will make you fishers of men. 20 And they straightway left their nets, and FOLLOWED HIM.
 - Mat 4:21-22 (KJV) And going on from thence, HE saw other two brethren, James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother, in a ship with Zebedee their father, mending their nets; and HE <u>CALLED</u> them. 22 And they immediately left the ship and their father, and <u>FOLLOWED</u> HIM.




JESUS' Call to Follow as His Disciple



- JESUS provided the following COMMANDMENT for those seeking to COME AFTER HIM
 - Mat 16:24-26 (KJV) Then <u>said</u> JESUS unto HIS disciples, If <u>any</u> man will <u>COME</u> after ME, let him <u>DENY</u> himself, and <u>TAKE UP</u> his cross, and <u>FOLLOW</u> ME. 25 For whosoever WILL SAVE his life <u>SHALL</u> LOSE IT: and whosoever WILL LOSE his LIFE for MY SAKE SHALL FIND IT. 26 For what is a man PROFITED, if he shall <u>gain</u> the <u>whole</u> world, and LOSE HIS OWN SOUL? or what SHALL a man GIVE in EXCHANGE for HIS SOUL?
- JESUS is calling for individuals to FOLLOW HIM and to become HIS LEARNERS by being PUPILS of the WORD












A Covenant and NOT a Testament



- In the OC, Covenant translated from the Hebrew word, ber-eeth'
 - From H1262 (in the sense of cutting (like H1254)); a compact (because made by passing between pieces of flesh): - confederacy, [con-]feder[-ate], covenant, league.
- beriyth appears 284 times in 264 verses (ALL in the OC)








A Covenant and NOT a Testament



- In the NC, Testament & Covenant translated from one Greek Word
 - diatheke (dee-ath-ay'-kay) From G1303; properly a disposition, that is, (specifically) a contract (especially a devisory will): covenant, testament diatheke appears ONLY in the NC 33 times in 33 verses







- JESUS Came to Establish a New Covenant, NOT a New Testament
 - Heb 8:6-8 (KJV) But now hath HE obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also HE is the MEDIATOR of a better COVENANT, which was established upon better PROMISES. 7 For if that FIRST COVENANT had been faultless, then should NO place have been sought for the SECOND. 8 For finding FAULT with them, HE saith, Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, when I will make a NEW COVENANT with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah:
 - Heb 8:13 (KJV) In that HE saith, A NEW COVENANT, he hath made the FIRST OLD. Now that which decayeth and waxeth old is ready to vanish away.





- The first covenant has a worldly sanctuary
 - Heb 9:1 (KJV) Then verily the FIRST <u>COVENANT</u> had also ordinances of divine service, and a <u>worldly</u> sanctuary.
- CHRIST established a new covenant in His Blood
 - Heb 9:11-14 (KJV) But CHRIST being come an HIGH PRIEST of GOOD things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, NOT made with hands, that is to say, NOT of this building; 12 NEITHER by the BLOOD of goats and calves, but by HIS own blood HE entered in ONCE into the HOLY PLACE, having obtained eternal redemption for us. 13 For if the BLOOD of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh: 14 How much more shall the BLOOD of CHRIST, WHO through the ETERNAL SPIRIT offered HIMSELF without spot to GOD, purge your CONSCIENCE from dead works to serve the living GOD?






- A testament is of no effect while a person lives; it requires the death of the testator before the testament takes effect
 - Heb 9:15-18 (KJV) And for this cause HE is the MEDIATOR of the new testament, that by means of death, for the REDEMPTION of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance. 16 For where a testament is, there MUST also of NECESSITY be the DEATH of the testator. 17 For a testament is of force after men are DEAD: otherwise it is of NO strength at all while the testator liveth. 18 Whereupon NEITHER the first testament was dedicated WITHOUT BLOOD.





- JESUS established the Covenant with His own Blood
 - Heb 10:28-29 (KJV) He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses: 29 Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the SON of GOD, and hath counted the BLOOD of the COVENANT, wherewith he was SANCTIFIED, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the SPIRIT of GRACE?







20. The NC Laws and Commandments



The NC Laws and Commandments



- JESUS, <u>AFTER</u> HE had <u>ASCENDED</u> back into Heaven, <u>SENT</u>


 <u>COMMANDMENTS</u> to the Apostles HE had chosen THROUGH the HOLY GHOST
 - Act 1:1-2 (KJV) The former treatise have I made, O Theophilus, of all that JESUS began both to DO and TEACH, 2 Until the day in which HE was TAKEN UP, AFTER that HE THROUGH the HOLY GHOST had GIVEN COMMANDMENTS UNTO the apostles whom HE HAD CHOSEN:



Commandment in the NC



Command/Commandments in NC 175 times in 164 verses





JESUS' Gave the Greatest Commandment



- JESUS defines the GREATEST Commandment (NOTE: the LAWS are contained within the COMMANDMENTS)
 - Mat 22:35-40 (KJV) Then one of them, which was a lawyer, asked HIM a question, tempting HIM, and saying, 36 MASTER, which is the great COMMANDMENT in the LAW? 37 JESUS said unto him, Thou shalt LOVE the LORD thy GOD with ALL thy HEART, and with ALL thy SOUL, and with ALL thy MIND. 38 This is the FIRST and great COMMANDMENT. 39 And the SECOND is like unto IT, Thou shalt LOVE thy neighbour as thyself. 40 On these TWO COMMANDMENTS hang all the LAW and the PROPHETS.



Paul's Correlation of NC and OC Laws



- Paul explains how the OC Commandments are fulfilled in the NC Laws
 - Rom 13:8-10 (KJV) Owe NO man any thing, but to LOVE one another: for he that LOVETH another hath fulfilled the LAW. 9 For this, Thou shalt NOT commit ADULTERY, Thou shalt NOT KILL, Thou shalt NOT STEAL, Thou shalt NOT BEAR FALSE WITNESS, Thou shalt NOT COVET; and if there be any other COMMANDMENT, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt LOVE thy neighbour as thyself. 10 LOVE worketh NO ill to his neighbour: therefore LOVE is the fulfilling of the LAW.



Peter Gives JESUS' Commandments



- Peters speaks of the WORDS of the Holy Prophets and the Commandments of the LORD's Apostles
 - 2Pe 3:1-2 (KJV) This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in both which I stir up your pure minds by way of remembrance: 2
 That ye may be mindful of the words which were spoken before by the holy prophets, and of the commandment of us the apostles of the Lord and Saviour:



Paul Provides the Purpose of the LORD's Commandments



- Paul gave us the LORD's Commandments to teach us "How-To Walk"
 - 1Th 4:1-6 (KJV) Furthermore then we beseech you, brethren, and **EXHORT** you by the LORD JESUS, that as ye have received of us HOW ye OUGHT to WALK and to PLEASE GOD, so ye would abound more and more. 2 For ye KNOW what COMMANDMENTS we gave you by the LORD JESUS. 3 For this is the WILL of GOD, even your SANCTIFICATION, that ye should ABSTAIN from fornication: 4 That every one of you should KNOW how to possess his vessel in **SANCTIFICATION** and honour; 5 NOT in the lust of concupiscence, even as the Gentiles which know NOT God: 6 That NO man go beyond and defraud his brother in any matter: because that the LORD is the AVENGER of all such, as we also have forewarned you and testified.



John Gives JESUS' Commandments



- John Gives Commandments
 - 1Jn 2:3-6 (KJV) And hereby we do know that we know HIM, if we keep HIS commandments. 4 He that saith, I know HIM, and keepeth not HIS COMMANDMENTS, is a LIAR, and the TRUTH is NOT in him. 5 But whoso keepeth his WORD, in him verily is the LOVE of GOD PERFECTED: hereby KNOW we that we are in him. 6 He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to WALK, even as HE WALKED.
 - WISDOM: "You can't be like someone, if you do not WALK with them"



John Gives Commandments



- John continues to give commandments
 - 1Jn 2:7-10 (KJV) Brethren, I write NO new COMMANDMENT unto you, but an old COMMANDMENT which ye had from the beginning. The old COMMANDMENT is the WORD which ye have heard from the beginning. 8 Again, a new COMMANDMENT I write unto you, which thing is true in him and in you: because the darkness is past, and the true light now shineth. 9 He that saith he is in the light, and hateth his brother, is in darkness even until now. 10 He that loveth his brother abideth in the light, and there is NONE occasion of stumbling in him.







21. The Kingdom of Heaven is Built on GOD's WORD – "What is Written"



Adam and Eve Misspoke the WORD



- GOD gave Adam a commandment in the Garden
 - Gen 2:16-17 (KJV) And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat: 17 But of the tree of the knowledge of GOOD and EVIL, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.
- Eve and Adam tempted but did not follow "What was written!"
 - Gen 3:2-3 (KJV) And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden: 3 But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die.

Eve and Adam did not follow GOD's WORD EXACTLY as Spoken and Sinned!



The World was Framed by GOD's WORD



- GOD spoke the world into existence!
 - Gen 1:1-3 (KJV) In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. 2 And the earth was without form, and void; and <u>darkness</u> was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. 3 And God said, <u>Let there be light</u>: and <u>there was light</u>.
- Word framed by the WORD of GOD
 - Heb 11:3 (KJV) Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the WORD of GOD, so that things which are seen were NOT made of things which do appear.



JESUS is the WORD



- JESUS is the WORD, and All things were made by HIM
 - Jhn 1:1-3 (KJV) In the beginning was the WORD, and the WORD was WORD was GOD. 2 The SAME was in the BEGINNING with GOD. 3 ALL things were made by HIM; and without HIM was NOT any thing made that was made.
- The WORD became FLESH (JESUS) and WALKED among us!
 - Jhn 1:14 (KJV) And the WORD was made FLESH, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld HIS glory, the glory as of the only BEGOTTEN of the FATHER,) full of grace and truth.



JESUS spoke "What was Written"



- JESUS defeated Tempter by QUOTING, "IT IS WRITTEN!"
 - Mat 4:1 (KJV) Then was JESUS led up of the SPIRIT into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil.
 - Mat 4:4 (KJV) But he answered and said, <u>IT IS WRITTEN</u>, Man shall <u>NOT</u> live by bread <u>alone</u>, but by EVERY <u>WORD</u> that proceedeth out of the mouth of <u>GOD</u>.
 - Mat 4:7 (KJV) Jesus said unto him, IT IS WRITTEN AGAIN, Thou shalt NOT TEMPT the LORD thy GOD.
 - Mat 4:10 (KJV) Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: FOR IT IS WRITTEN, Thou shalt worship the LORD thy GOD, and HIM ONLY shalt thou SERVE.




JESUS Proclaimed "It is Written"

GOD's WORD Never Pass Away



- The WORD of GOD is Eternal
 - Mat 24:35 (KJV) Heaven and earth shall pass away, but MY WORDS shall NOT pass away.
 - Mat 5:17-18 (KJV) Think not that I AM come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am NOT come to destroy, but to fulfil. 18 For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in NO wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.
- The WORD is our ONLY WEAPON against Satan
 - Eph 6:17 (KJV) And take the helmet of salvation, and the SWORD of the SPIRIT which is the word of God:



All Scriptures is Given by the Inspiration of GOD



- All Scriptures is GIVEN by the INSPIRATION (HOLY SPIRIT) of GOD
 - 2Ti 3:14-17 (KJV) But continue thou in the things which thou hast LEARNED and hast been assured of, knowing of whom thou hast LEARNED them; 15 And that from a child thou hast known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make thee WISE unto SALVATION through FAITH which is in CHRIST JESUS. 16 All Scripture is given by INSPIRATION of GOD, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: 17 That the man of GOD may be perfect, throughly furnished unto ALL GOOD works.



The WORD is our ONLY Weapon



- The WORD is our ONLY WEAPON against Satan
 - Eph 6:17 (KJV) And take the helmet of salvation, and the SWORD of the SPIRIT which is the word of God:
- The word is sharper than any two-edged Sword
 - Heb 4:12-13 (KJV) For the word of God *is* quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and *is* a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. 13 Neither is there any creature that is not manifest in his sight: but all things *are* naked and opened unto the eyes of him with whom we have to do.



The WORD enables us to Control the Thoughts of our Imagination



- The WORD is the WEAPON Disciples must Wield to control the Thoughts of their Imagination
 - 2Co 10:3-5 (KJV) For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: 4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) 5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;



JESUS sent the WORD to Cleanse Us



- JESUS wants to Sanctify and Cleanse Disciples by the Washing of water by the WORD
 - Eph 5:25-27 (KJV) Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; 26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, 27 That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.
- GOD washed the wickedness away by the waters of the flood that killed those filled with evil thoughts
- JESUS wants to wash away evil thoughts with the WORD to sanctify and cleanse those who want to be His Bride and future Heavenly Wife




GOD'S WORD brings us LIFE and they are ETERNAL!



- The WORDS of JESUS CHRIST give us LIFE!
 - Jhn 6:63 (KJV) It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.
- ONLY the WORDS of JESUS give us Eternal Life
 - Jhn 6:67-68 (67) Then said Jesus unto the twelve, Will ye also go away? (68) Then Simon Peter answered him, Lord, to whom shall we go? thou hast the words of eternal life.
- GOD's WORDS SHALL NEVER PASS AWAY
 - Mat 24:35 HEAVEN and EARTH SHALL PASS AWAY, BUT MY WORDS SHALL NOT PASS AWAY.







22. Precepts of the Kingdom of Heaven



Three States of Words in the World



- TRUTH = What is written (GOD's and JESUS' WORDS)
 - Jhn 17:17 (KJV) Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.
- TRUE = What the HOLY SPIRIT reveals about "What is Written" (Heavenly Interpretation)
 - Rev 2:7 (KJV) He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.....
- FALSE = Mankind's private interpretation that opposes "What is Written" and What is Revealed by the HOLY SPIRIT
 - 2Pe 1:20-21 (KJV) Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation. 21 For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.



New Covenant vs New Testament



- The Holy Spirit has guided me to focus on the New Covenant (NC) in lieu of the commonly given name, the New Testament (NT)
- JESUS did NOT come to establishment a New Testament
- JESUS came with and delivered His Testament, which became the New Covenant when He died and shed His Blood to cleanse our Sins







23. New Born Babes in JESUS CHRIST Must Have the WORD to Grow!



Peter Commanded to Feed the LORD's Sheep



- JESUS told Peter to feed my Sheep (St. John 21:15-17)
 - 15. So when they had dined, Jesus saith to Simon Peter, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me more than these? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my lambs.
 - 16. He saith to him again the second time, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my sheep.
 - 17. He saith unto him the third time, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me? Peter was grieved because he said unto him the third time, Lovest thou me? And he said unto him, Lord, thou knowest all things; thou knowest that I love thee. Jesus saith unto him, Feed my sheep.



Newborn Babes Need the WORD



- Peter fulfilled JESUS' commandment by commanding newborn babes to desire the sincere milk of GOD's Word (1 Pet. 2:1-3)
 - 1. Wherefore <u>laying aside</u> all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings,
 - 2. As newborn babes, <u>desire</u> the <u>sincere</u> milk of the <u>word</u>, that ye may <u>grow</u> thereby:
 - 3. If so be ye have tasted that the Lord is gracious.



Peter Commands Paul's Writings



- Peter ended his writings by commanding Disciples to read the writings of Paul and those who refuse do so to their own Destruction (2 Pet. 3:14-18)
 - 14. Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him in peace, without spot, and blameless.
 - 15. And account that the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation; even as our beloved brother Paul also according to the wisdom given unto him hath written unto you;
 - 16. As also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things; in which are some things hard to be understood, which they that are unlearned and unstable wrest, as they do also the other scriptures, unto their own destruction.
 - 17. Ye therefore, beloved, seeing ye know these things before, beware lest ye also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your own stedfastness.
 - 18. But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and for ever. Amen.



Babes are Unskillful in the WORD



- Paul warns those Disciples who have not grown in the Word (Heb. 5:11-14)
 - 11. Of whom we have many things to say, and hard to be uttered, seeing ye are dull of hearing.
 - 12. For when for the time ye <u>ought</u> to be teachers, ye <u>have need</u> that one <u>teach</u> you <u>again</u> which be the <u>first principles of the oracles</u> of God; and are become such as <u>have need</u> of milk, and <u>not</u> of strong meat.
 - 13. For every one that useth milk is <u>unskilful</u> in the <u>word of righteousness</u>: for he is a babe.
 - 14. But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both GOOD and EVIL.
