JESUS CHRIST sent Paul to be the Lawgiver to the NT Church

Acts 1:1-2 "The former treatise have I made, O Theophilus, of all that JESUS began both to do and teach, UNTIL the day in which HE was TAKEN UP, AFTER that he through the Holy Ghost had GIVEN COMMANDMENTS unto the APOSTLES whom he had CHOSEN:

(Gal 1:8-9, 11-12)


- 8. But though WE, or an ANGEL from HEAVEN, PREACH ANY OTHER GOSPEL unto YOU than that which WE HAVE PREACHED unto YOU, let him be ACCURSED.
- 9. As we SAID BEFORE, so SAY I now AGAIN, If ANY MAN PREACH ANY OTHER GOSPEL unto YOU than that ye HAVE RECEIVED, let him be ACCURSED.
- 11. But I CERTIFY YOU, brethren, that THE GOSPEL which was PREACHED of ME is NOT AFTER MAN.
- 12. For I NEITHER RECEIVED it of MAN, NEITHER was I TAUGHT IT, but by the REVELATION of JESUS CHRIST.



Did Paul write Hebrews?



Origins of the book of Hebrews

- Hebrews is a book whose content was given to Paul by GOD
 - 1. The only book in the Holy Scriptures that begins with "GOD"
 - a) Paul's other 13 books begin with His name, "Paul"
 - 2. The only book that gives the lineage of Melchisedec (Heb. 5-7) (Genesis 14:17 Melchizedek, King of Salem brought bread and wine, and he was the priest of the most high GOD)
 - 3. Tells the testimony of Enoch and other saints that was not previously known (Heb. 11)
 - 4. Reveals that JESUS CHRIST came to perform the volume of the book written of Him (Heb 10:1-7) (Psa. 40:6-7)
 - 5. Appointed unto man, once to die; after that judgment (Heb. 9:27)



Is there a Scriptural Graduation Pattern?



- What does it look like to walk and live as a TRUE Disciple and Follower of JESUS CHRIST (What does discipleship look like?)
- Are there specific areas of knowledge that JESUS and GOD expect a mature Disciple to know? (Did our Heavenly Father leave us graduation protocols?)
- Did the requirement for Discipleship change since JESUS first called man to be His Disciples? (Should Discipleship today look the same in terms of life, learning, and commitments as seen by the original Disciples?)
- Should those who seek to follow Christ, earnestly read and study the Holy Scriptures so they will KNOW HOW to Walk with JESUS CHRIST today? (2 Tim 4:7)



First Oracles of GOD



Hebrews 5:11-14

- 11. Of whom we have many things to say (of Melchisedec), and hard to be uttered, seeing ye are dull of hearing.
- 12. FOR when for the time YE OUGHT to be TEACHERS, ye have NEED that one TEACH YOU AGAIN which be the FIRST PRINCIPLES of the ORACLES of GOD; and are become such as have NEED of MILK, and NOT of STRONG MEAT.
- 13. For every one that useth MILK is UNSKILFUL in the WORD of RIGHTEOUSNESS: for he is a BABE.
- 14. But <u>STRONG MEAT</u> belongeth to them that are of <u>FULL AGE</u>, even those who by <u>REASON</u> of <u>USE</u> have their <u>SENSES EXERCISED</u> to <u>DISCERN</u> both GOOD and <u>EVIL</u>.



7 Principles of the Doctrine of Christ



Hebrews 6:1-6

- Therefore <u>LEAVING</u> the <u>PRINCIPLES of the DOCTRINE of CHRIST</u>, let us go on unto (1) <u>PERFECTION</u>; NOT LAYING AGAIN the FOUNDATION of (2) <u>REPENTANCE</u> from DEAD WORKS, and of (3) <u>FAITH</u> toward <u>GOD</u>,
- 2. Of the DOCTRINE of (4) <u>BAPTISMS</u>, and of (5) <u>LAYING on of HANDS</u>, and of (6) <u>RESURRECTION of the DEAD</u>, and of (7) <u>ETERNAL JUDGMENT</u>.
- 3. And this will we do, **IF** GOD permit.
- 4. For it is IMPOSSIBLE for those who were ONCE ENLIGHTENED, and have TASTED of the HEAVENLY GIFTS, and were made PARTAKERS of the HOLY GHOST,
- 5. And have <u>TASTED</u> the <u>GOOD WORD</u> of <u>GOD</u>, and the <u>POWERS</u> of the <u>WORLD to COME</u>,
- 6. IF THEY SHALL FALL AWAY, to RENEW THEM AGAIN unto REPENTANCE; seeing they CRUCIFY to THEMSELVES the SON of GOD AFRESH, and PUT HIM to an OPEN SHAME.



Doctrine 1 - Perfection



Going On unto Perfection (Heb. 6:1)

Perfection is running the race to seek of the Kingdom of GOD and His Righteousness

Learning Objectives:

- 1. Understand the scriptures on perfection
- 2. Describe and explain the need for Disciples to pursue perfection

Key Discipleship Study Focus:

- 1. Be ye therefore perfect as your Father is in Heaven (St. Matt. 5:48)
- 2. Disciples meant to be perfect in one with the FATHER and SON) (St. John 17:23)
- 3. Called to perfect holiness in the fear of GOD (2 Cor. 7:1)
- 4. Gifts of the ministry sent for the perfecting of the saints until we come in the knowledge of the SON of GOD, unto a perfect man (Eph. 4:11-16)



Run the Race for Perfection



Many were not even aware there was a RACE, much less of the need to run it.

Hebrews 12:1-3

- 1. Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and LET US RUN with PATIENCE the RACE that is SET BEFORE US,
- 2. LOOKING unto JESUS the AUTHOR and FINISHER of OUR FAITH; who for the JOY that was set before him ENDURED the CROSS, DESPISING the SHAME, and is SET DOWN at the RIGHT HAND of the THRONE of GOD.
- 3. For consider HIM that <u>ENDURED</u> such <u>CONTRADITION of SINNERS</u> <u>AGAINST HIMSELF, <u>LEST</u> ye be WEARIED and FAINT in <u>YOUR MINDS</u>.</u>



Run the Race for Perfection



Paul was temperate in all things and kept his body under subjection!

- 1 Cor. 9:24-27
 - 24. KNOW YE NOT that they which RUN IN A RACE RUN ALL, but one receiveth the prize? SO RUN, that ye MAY OBTAIN.
 - 25. And every man that STRIVETH for the MASTERY is TEMPERATE in ALL THINGS. Now they do it to obtain a corruptible crown; but WE an INCORRUPTIBLE.
 - 26. I therefore SO RUN, not as uncertainly; so FIGHT I, not as one that beateth the air:
 - 27. But I KEEP under my BODY, and BRING IT into SUBJECTION: LEST that by ANY MEANS, when I have PREACHED to OTHERS, I MYSELF should be A CASTAWAY.

Castway: G96. adokimos, ad-ok'-ee-mos; UNAPPROVED, i.e. REJECTED; by impl. WORTHLESS (lit. or mor.):--castaway, rejected, REPROBATE.



Run the Race for Perfection



Paul Ran the Race to Perfection

- 2 Tim. 4:7-8
 - 7. I HAVE <u>FOUGHT</u> a GOOD FIGHT, I HAVE <u>FINISHED</u> <u>MY COURSE</u>, I HAVE <u>KEPT</u> the FAITH:
 - 8. HENCEFORTH there is <u>LAID UP</u> for <u>ME</u> A <u>CROWN</u> of RIGHTEOUSNESS, which the <u>LORD</u>, the <u>RIGHTEOUS JUDGE</u>, <u>SHALL GIVE <u>ME</u> at <u>THAT DAY</u>: and <u>NOT</u> to <u>ME</u> <u>ONLY</u>, but unto <u>ALL THEM</u> also that LOVE HIS <u>APPEARING</u>.</u>

TIME for ALL DISCIPLES to GET INTO THEIR OWN RACE!



Doctrine 1 – Perfection



Other Scriptures that are part of the Scriptural Pattern of Repentance:

- 1. Purse the good, and acceptable, and PERFECT will of GOD (Rom. 12:1-2)
- 2. Seek to be PERFECTLY joined together in the Body of CHRIST (1 Cor. 1:10)
- 3. PERFECTING holiness in the fear of GOD (2 Cor. 7:1)
- 4. GOD's strength is made PERFECT in weakness (2 Cor. 12:9)
- 5. Paul commanded us to be PERFECT (2 Cor. 13:9-11)
- 6. Ministry gifts given for the PERFECTING of the Saints (Eph. 4:11-16)
- 7. Paul acknowledge he was not perfected but was pressing for the mark of the prize of the high calling of GOD in CHRIST JESUS (Phil. 3:12-15)
- 8. Paul warns disciples so he may present every man perfect in CHRIST JESUS (Col 1:28)



Doctrine 1 – Perfection



Other Scriptures that are part of the Scriptural Pattern of Repentance:

- 9. Paul prays that he might PERFECT that which is lacking in the Disciple's faith (1 Thess. 3:10)
- 10. All scripture is given by inspiration of GOD that the man of GOD may be PERFECT, thoroughly furnished unto all good works (2 Tim. 3:16-17)
- 11. Disciples should be made PERFECT in every good work (Heb. 13:21)
- 12. After that Disciples have suffered a while, we are made PERFECT (1 Pet. 5:10)
- 13. Whoso keepeth GOD's WORD, in him is the love of GOD PERFECTED (1 John 2:5)
- 14. There is no fear in love, but PERFECT love casteth out fear (1 John 4:18)
- 15. The church in Sardis was told to strengthen the things which remain and are ready to die, because JESUS had not found their works PERFECT before GOD (Rev. 3:1-6)



Doctrine 2 - Repentance



Not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works (Heb. 6:1) Repentance means to "THINK DIFFERENTLY"

Learning Objectives

- 1. Understand the scriptural definition of "Repent"
- 2. Understand the scriptural pattern of Repentance and dead works

Key Discipleship Study Focus:

- 1. Repent is from Greek word "metanoeo" meaning to "think differently"
- 2. Must Repent to enter the Kingdom of Heaven (St. Matt. 4:17)
- 3. Must Repent to be saved and receive the HOLY GHOST (Acts 2:37-38)
- 4. John baptized with water unto repentance (3:2-11)



Doctrine 2 – Repentance



Other Scriptures that are part of the Scriptural Pattern of Repentance:

- 1. JESUS came to call sinner to REPENTANCE (St. Mark 2:17)
- 2. Except we REPENT, we shall all likewise perish (St. Luke 13:1-5)
- 3. More joy in heaven over one sinner that <u>REPENTETH</u> than over 99 just people (St. Luke 15:7-10)
- 4. Paul preached that individuals should REPENT and turn to GOD (Acts 26:20)
- 5. GODLY sorrow worketh <u>REPENTANCE</u> to salvation not to be REPENTED of (2 Cor. 7:10)
- 6. Church of Ephesus was commanded by JESUS to REPENT (Rev. 2:5)
- 7. Church of Pergamum was commanded by JESUS to REPENT (Rev. 2:16)
- 8. Church of Thyatira was commanded by JESUS to REPENT (Rev. 2:21)



Doctrine 2 – Repentance



Other Scriptures that are part of the Scriptural Pattern of Repentance:

- 9. Church of Sardis was commanded by JESUS to REPENT (Rev. 3:3)
- 10. Church of Laodicea was commanded by JESUS to REPENT (Rev. 3:19)
- 11. During the great tribulation, many will not REPENT (Rev. 9:20-21, 16:9-11)



Doctrine 3 - Faith



Faith towards GOD (Heb. 6:1)

Faith is the substance of things hoped for; the evidence of things not seen. Those who come to GOD must FIRST believe that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him

Learning Objectives:

- 1. Understand the scriptural requirement for faith
- 2. Describe and teach its significance for a Disciple's salvation

Key Discipleship Study Focus:

- 1. He that cometh to GOD must FIRST believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him (Heb. 11:5)
- 2. Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen (Heb. 11:1



Doctrine 3 – Faith



Other Scriptures that are part of the Scriptural Pattern of Faith:

- 1. Trust in the LORD with all thine heart, and lean not to thine own understanding (Prov. 3:5-6)
- 2. We are saved by Grace through FAITH (Eph. 2:8-9)
- 3. The just shall live by FAITH (Rom. 1:17)
- 4. Righteousness of GOD which is by the FAITH of JESUS CHRIST (Rom. 3:22)
- 5. A man is justified by FAITH without the deeds of the law (Rom. 3:27-28)
- 6. FAITH is counted for righteousness to him that believeth (Rom. 4:5-9)
- 7. Disciples are justified by FAITH (Rom. 5:1-2)
- 8. Gentiles attained to righteousness by FAITH (Rom. 9:30-32)
- 9. We are saved by our words of FAITH and belief in our hearts (Rom. 10:8-13)



Doctrine 3 – Faith



Other Scriptures that are part of the Scriptural Pattern of Faith:

- 10. FAITH cometh by hearing, and hearing by the WORD of GOD (Rom. 10:17)
- 11. GOD has dealt to every man the measure of FAITH (Rom. 12:3-8)
- 12. Whatsoever is not of FAITH is sin (Rom. 14:22-23)
- 13. One's FAITH should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of GOD (1 Cor. 2:1-5)
- 14. FAITH is a gift of the SPIRIT (1 Cor. 12:9)
- 15. Now abideth FAITH, hope, charity; the the greatest is charity (1 Cor. 13:13)
- 16. For we walk by FAITH, not by sight (2 Cor. 5:7)
- 17. Examine ourselves, whether we be in the faith (2 Cor. 13:5)



Doctrine 3 – Faith



Other Scriptures that are part of the Scriptural Pattern of Faith:

- 18. Disciples are not justified by the works of the law, but by the FAITH of JESUS CHRIST (Gal. 2:16)
- 19. Disciples should live by the FAITH of the SON of GOD who loved us (Gal. 2:20)
- 20. Those of FAITH are blessed with FAITHFUL Abraham (Gal. 3:9)
- 21. Disciples are all the children of GOD by FAITH in JESUS CHRIST (Gal. 3:26)
- 22. One LORD, one FAITH, one baptism (Eph. 4:5)
- 23. Take the shield of FAITH (Eph. 6:16)
- 24. Hold the mystery of FAITH in a pure conscience (1 Tim. 3:9)
- 25. But without FAITH it is impossible to please GOD (Heb. 11:6)



Doctrine 4 - Baptisms



Doctrine of Baptisms (Heb. 6:2)

Disciples should be baptized of the water unto repentance, of the HOLY GHOST, and the WORD of GOD

Learning Objectives:

- 1. Describe the baptism of water unto Repentance
- 2. Describe the baptism of the HOLY GHOST
- 3. Describe the baptism of the WORD of GOD

Key Discipleship Study Focus:

- 1. Repent and be baptized of water, confessing one's sins (St. Matt. 3:2, 6)
- 2. Repent, and be Baptized to receive the HOLY SPIRIT (Acts 2:37-39)
- 3. JESUS came to seek a bride and cleanse her by the washing of the Word (Eph. 5:25-27)



Doctrine 4 – Baptisms



Other Scriptures that are part of the Scriptural Pattern of Baptism:

- 1. JESUS was Baptized of John (St. Matt. 3:13-17)
- 2. JESUS will baptized His Disciples with the HOLY GHOST (St. Mark 1:8)
- 3. Go ye therefore and teach all nations, and baptize them in the name of the FATHER, and of the SON, and of the HOLY GHOST (St. Matt. 28:18-20)
- 4. 3000 souls were baptized on the Day of Pentecost (Acts 2:41)
- 5. Philip baptized those who believed (Acts 8:13)
- 6. We are baptized into JESUS' death (Rom. 6:1-23)
- 7. By one SPIRIT are we all baptized into one body (1 Cor. 12:13)
- 9. For as many have been baptized into CHRIST have put on CHRIST (Gal. 3:27)



Doctrine 4 – Baptisms



Other Scriptures that are part of the Scriptural Pattern of Baptism:

- 9. Disciples are buried with CHRIST in baptism (Col. 2:12)
- 10. There is one LORD, one faith, and one baptism (Eph. 4:5)
- 11. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved (St. Mark 16:16)
- 12. Children of Israel were baptized to Moses in the sea (1 Cor. 10:2)
- 13. Cornelius and his household were baptized after receiving the HOLY GHOST (Acts 10:47-48)
- 14. Saul was baptized after his conversion (Acts 9:18)
- 15. Philip baptized the Eunuch upon his profession of JESUS CHRIST (Acts 8:36)



Doctrine 5 – Laying on of Hands (Gifts)



Laying on of Hands (Heb. 6:2)

Teaching about the gifts and callings given to each Disciples by the HOLY SPIRIT for the EDIFICATION (building up) of the Body of JESUS CHRIST (the Church)

Learning Objectives

- 1. Understand the scriptural teachings of "GIFTS and CALLINGS" given to Disciples
- 2. Describe and explain the need for "ALL" disciples to exercise their gifts and callings

Key Discipleship Study Focus:

- 1. JESUS gave <u>Apostles</u>, <u>Prophets</u>, <u>Evangelist</u>, <u>Pastors</u> and <u>Teachers</u> for the PERFECTING of the SAINTS (Disciples) unto a <u>MATURE man</u> (Eph. 4:11-16)
- 2. The manifestation of the HOLY SPIRIT is given to "ALL" men to profit withal (1 Cor. 12:7



Doctrine 5 – Laying on of Hands (Gifts)



Other Scriptures that are part of the Scriptural Pattern of Laying on of Hands (Gifts):

- 1. Gifts given by the HOLY SPIRIT to Disciples (1 Cor. 12:1-11)
- 2. Many members but **ONE BODY** of JESUS CHRIST (1 Cor. 12:12-31)
- 3. Gifts of grace given by the HOLY SPIRIT to Disciples (Rom. 12:3-21)



Doctrine 6 – Resurrection of the Dead



Resurrection of the Dead (Heb. 6:2)

- 1. It is critical for Disciples to **BELIEVE** in the RESURRECTION of the **DEAD**
- 2. There will be a **FINAL JUDGMENT**
- 3. Believing in the RESURRECTION and JUDGEMENT will **GUIDE** DISCIPLES as they **RUN** THEIR **RACE** to achieve **PERFECTION**

Learning Objectives:

1. Understand the Scriptural Pattern of the Resurrection of the Dead

Key Discipleship Study Focus:

- 1. JESUS prophesied He would raise up on the third day (St. Matt. 17:22-23, 20:17-19)
- 2. Resurrection of the dead and the marriage in Heaven (St. Matt. 22:23-33)



Doctrine 6 – Resurrection of the Dead



Other Scriptures that are part of the Scriptural Pattern of Resurrection:

- 1. Disciples will be like the angels when they are RESURRECTED (St. Matt. 22:23-33)
- 2. Saints were resurrected and walked into Jerusalem at JESUS' death on the cross (St. Matt. 27:53)
- 3. JESUS CHRIST is the RESURRECTION and the life (St. John 11:25)
- 4. JESUS CHRIST's soul was not left in hell but RESURRECTED (Acts 2:321)
- Disciples taught and preached through JESUS the RESURRECTION of the dead (Acts. 4:2)
- 6. Apostles witnessed of the RESURRECTION of JESUS CHRIST (Acts 4:33)
- 7. Paul preached of JESUS' RESURRECTION on Mars Hill in Athens (Acts. 17:32)
- 8. Sadducees say there is no RESURRECTION, neither angle, nor spirit; but the Pharisees confess both (Acts 24:15)



Doctrine 6 – Resurrection of the Dead



Other Scriptures that are part of the Scriptural Pattern of Resurrection:

- 9. JESUS declared to be the SON of GOD by His RESURRECTION from the dead (Rom 6:5)
- 10. There is a RESURRECTION of the dead for JESUS and Disciples (1 Cor. 15:12-49)
- 11. We shall not all sleep, but we shall be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye (1 Cor. 15:50-58)
- 12. That we may know CHRIST, and the power of His RESURRECTION (Phil. 3:9-11)
- 13. Blessed are they who hath part in the first RESURRECTION (Rev. 20:5-6)





Eternal Judgment (Heb. 6:1)

- 1. ISSUE: Many do not study these teachings because they are afraid and fearful
- 2. It is APPOINTED unto MAN ONCE to DIE, but AFTER this the JUDGMENT (Heb. 9:27)
- 3. We MUST PREPARE for JESUS' RETURN

Learning Objectives:

- 1. Understand and explain the Scriptural Pattern of Eternal Judgment
- 2. Understand and explain its importance to Disciples

Key Discipleship Study Focus:

- 1. Live a life so JESUS say "WELL DONE!" (St. Matt. 25:21, 23)
- 2. Understand that KEEPING JESUS' COMMANDMENTS are REQUIRED to enter the kingdom of Heaven (Rev. 21:7, 22:15)
- 3. Understand the THOUGHTS and ACTIONS (FRUIT, WORKS) that WILL NOT ENTER the Kingdom of Heaven (Rev. 21:8, 22:15)





- Two (2) of the most profound Scriptures, a question and a statement
 - 1. (St. Matt. 16:26) For WHAT is a man profited, if he shall GAIN the whole world, and LOSE HIS OWN SOUL? or WHAT shall a man give in EXCHANGE for HIS SOUL?
 - 2. (Heb. 9:27) And as it is APPOINTED unto men ONCE TO DIE, but AFTER this THE JUDGMENT:
- JESUS explains the entrance to Heaven
 - 1. (Rev 21:7 KJV) He that **OVERCOMETH** SHALL INHERIT ALL THINGS; and I will be his GOD, and he shall be MY SON.
 - 2. (Rev 21:8 KJV) But the **FEARFUL**, and **UNBELIEVING**, and the **ABOMINABLE**, and **MURDERS**, and **WHOREMONGERS**, and **SORCERERS**, and **IDOLATERS**, and **ALL LIARS**, shall have **THEIR PART** in the **LAKE** which BURNETH with FIRE and BRIMSTONE: which is the **SECOND DEATH**.





Other Scriptures that are part of the Scriptural Pattern of Eternal Judgment:

- 1. Straight and Narrow way to Heaven (St. Matt. 7:12-14)
- 2. <u>False Prophets</u> (St. Matt. 7:15-20)
- 3. I Never Knew You/building on the Rock (St. Matt. 7:21-28)
- 4. Parable of the Unforgiving Servant (St. Matt. 18:21-35)
