GOD revealed why he destroyed the earth the first time in Genesis 6:5-7

- 5. And GOD SAW that the WICKEDNESS of MAN was GREAT in the earth, and that EVERY IMAGINATION of the THOUGHTS of his HEART was ONLY EVIL CONTINUALLY.
- 6. And it <u>REPENTED</u> the LORD that HE had MADE MAN on the earth, and it <u>GRIEVED</u> HIM at HIS <u>HEART</u>.
- 7. And the LORD said, I will <u>DESTROY</u> MAN whom I have CREATED from the FACE of the EARTH; BOTH MAN, and BEAST, and the CREEPING THINGS, and the FOWLS of the AIR; for it <u>REPENTETH</u> ME that I have <u>MADE THEM</u>.

GOD's Voice Walked in the Garden



GOD's <u>VOICE</u> <u>WALKED</u> in the Garden in Genesis 3:8-10

- 8. And they <u>HEARD</u> the <u>VOICE</u> of the <u>LORD GOD</u> <u>WALKING</u> in the GARDEN in the COOL of the day: and Adam and his wife HID themselves from the <u>PRESENCE</u> of the <u>LORD GOD</u> amongst the TREES of the GARDEN.
- 9. And the LORD GOD CALLED unto Adam, and said unto him, WHERE ART THOU?
- 10. And he said, I <u>HEARD THY VOICE</u> in the garden, and I was AFRAID, because I was NAKED; and I HID MYSELF.
- **<u>FIRST</u>** appearance of "<u>WALKING</u>" in the Holy Scriptures
- GOD created MAN so He could <u>WALK</u> with THEM in <u>FELLOWSHIP</u>
- <u>NO</u> reference to Adam <u>SEEING</u> GOD's Body <u>ONLY HEARD GOD's VOICE</u>

WE WALK WITH GOD IN THE THOUGHTS OF THE IMAGINATION OF OUR HEART!!

ENOCH walked with GOD and was the FIRST person "<u>CAUGHT UP</u>" to forever live with the LORD (Gen. 5:22-24)

- 22. And ENOCH WALKED with GOD after he begat Methuselah three hundred years, and begat sons and daughters:
- 23. And <u>all</u> the days of ENOCH were three hundred sixty and five years:
- 24. And ENOCH WALKED with GOD: and HE WAS NOT; for GOD TOOK HIM.

ENOCH, the 7th from Adam, PLEASED <u>GOD</u> and did <u>NOT</u> DIE (Heb. 11:5, Jude 1:14)

- (Hebrews) By FAITH ENOCH was <u>TRANSLATED</u> that he should <u>NOT SEE</u> <u>DEATH</u>; and was <u>NOT FOUND</u>, because <u>GOD</u> had <u>TRANSLATED him</u>: for BEFORE his <u>TRANSLATION</u> he had this TESTIMONY, that he <u>PLEASED</u> <u>GOD</u>.
- 14. (JUDE) And Enoch also, the <u>SEVENTH from Adam</u>, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the <u>LORD</u> cometh with ten thousands of his saints,







Paul explains the necessity of the WALK to PLEASE GOD in 1 Thess. 4:1-4

- 1. Furthermore then we **BEESCH YOU, BRETHERN**, and **EXHORT YOU** by the LORD JESUS, that as YE have **RECEIVED OF US** HOW YE OUGHT to WALK and to **PLEASE GOD**, so YE would ABOUND MORE and MORE.
- 2. For YE KNOW what COMMANDMENTS WE GAVE YOU BY the LORD JESUS.
- 3. For this is the WILL of GOD, even YOUR SANCTIFICATION, that YE should **ABSTAIN from FORNICATION:**
- 4. That EVERY ONE of YOU SHOULD KNOW HOW to POSSESS HIS VESSEL (10) Virgins, 5 had vessels with OIL) in **SANCTIFICATION** and **HONOUR**;
- 5. NOT in the LUST of CONCUPISCENCE, even as the GENTILES which KNOW NOT GOD:
- 6. That <u>NO man go beyond and DEFRAUD HIS BROTHER in ANY MATTER</u>: because that the LORD is the AVENGER of ALL such, as WE ALSO have FOREWARNED **YOU** and testified.

Noah Walked with GOD



<u>NOAH</u> (600 at the flood) learned to <u>WALK</u> with GOD from <u>LAMECH</u> (777 years), who learned from <u>METHUSELAH</u> (969 years), who learned from <u>ENOCH</u> (365 years)

GENESIS 6:8-9

- 8. But <u>NOAH</u> found <u>GRACE</u> in the eyes of the <u>LORD</u>.
- 9. These are the generations of <u>NOAH</u>: <u>NOAH</u> was a JUST MAN and <u>PERFECT in his</u> <u>GENERATIONS</u>, and <u>NOAH</u> <u>WALKED</u> with <u>GOD</u>.
- NOAH had the assistance of Lamech and Methuselah in building the Ark
 - <u>Noah</u> spent <u>100 years</u> building the Ark
 - Lamech died <u>5 years</u> before the flood (lived a perfect 777 years)
 - Methuselah died the year of the flood (longest living person in Scriptures; Grace)

GOD called Abram (Abraham) to leave his family and travel to a land that he would later inherit (Gen. 12:1-4)

- 1. Now the LORD had said unto <u>ABRAM</u>, <u>GET THEE</u> OUT OF THY COUNTRY, and <u>FROM THY</u> KINDRED, and <u>FROM THY</u> FATHER'S HOUSE, UNTO A LAND THAT I WILL SHOW THEE:
- 2. And I will MAKE of <u>thee</u> a GREAT NATION, and I will BLESS <u>THEE</u>, and MAKE <u>THY NAME GREAT</u>; and <u>THOU</u> SHALT BE A BLESSING:
- 3. And I will BLESS THEM that BLESS THEE, and CURSE HIM that CURSETH THEE: and IN THEE SHALL ALL FAMILES OF THE EARTH BE BLESSED.
- So <u>ABRAM DEPARTED</u>, as the <u>LORD</u> <u>HAD SPOKEN</u> unto <u>him</u>; and Lot went with <u>him</u>: and <u>ABRAM</u> was seventy and five years old when <u>he DEPARTED</u> out of HARAN.







Israel had to walk with GOD, from the bondage of Egypt, through the wilderness of life, to reach the Promised Land (Gen. 13:20-22)

- 20. And they (the children of Israel) took their journey from Succoth, and encamped in Etham, in the edge of the WILDERNESS.
- 21. And the LORD went BEFORE THEM by DAY in a <u>PILLAR of a CLOUD</u>, to LEAD THEM the WAY; and by NIGHT in a <u>PILLAR of FIRE</u>, to GIVE THEM LIGHT; to go by DAY and NIGHT:
- 22. <u>He</u> took NOT AWAY the <u>PILLAR of the CLOUD</u> by DAY, NOR the <u>PILLAR of FIRE</u> by NIGHT, FROM BEFORE the PEOPLE.

(Psa 119:105) <u>THY</u> WORD is a <u>LAMP</u> unto my FEET, and a <u>LIGHT</u> unto my PATH. (Rom 8:14) For as MANY as are <u>LED</u> by the <u>SPIRIT of GOD</u>, THEY are the SONS of GOD.







Elijah thought he alone was WALKING with GOD

- 1 King 19:14, 17-18
- 14. And he (Elijah) said, I have been very jealous for the LORD GOD of HOSTS: because the <u>children of Israel</u> have <u>forsaken thy covenant</u>, <u>thrown down</u> <u>thine altars</u>, and <u>slain thy prophets</u> with the sword; and I, even I only, am left; and <u>they seek</u> my life, to <u>take it away</u>.
- 17. And it shall come to pass, that him that escapeth the sword of Hazael shall Jehu slay: and him that escapeth from the sword of Jehu shall Elisha slay.
- 18. Yet <u>I (the LORD) have LEFT ME</u> SEVEN THOUSAND in Israel, <u>ALL</u> the KNEES which <u>HAVE NOT BOWED</u> unto <u>Baal</u>, and EVERY MOUTH which <u>HATH NOT</u> <u>KISSED him</u>.





Individual's had to leave all behind and WALK with JESUS to be His Disciples during his earthly ministry

- 1. JESUS called Simon Peter and Andrew to FOLLOW Him (St. Matt. 4:18-19)
- JESUS called James and John to <u>FOLLOW</u> Him (St. Matt. 4:21-22)
- 3. Great multitudes FOLLOWED JESUS (St. Matt. 4:25; 8:1)
- 4. JESUS called Matthew to FOLLOW Him (St. Matt 9:9-13)
- JESUS commanded that those who DO NOT TAKE HIS CROSS and FOLLOW ME, is NOT WORTHY of ME (St. Matt 10:38-39)
- Peter told JESUS that they had <u>LEFT ALL to FOLLOW</u> Him (St. Matt. 19:27-28)
- 7. One disciple wanted to go bury his father first, but JESUS instructed him to, "FOLLOW Me, and let the dead bury their dead." (St. Matt 8:18-22)

Apostles' discussion on walking with JESUS CHRIST

- 1. There is no condemnation to them which are in CHRIST JESUS, who WALK not after the flesh but after the SPIRIT (Rom. 8:1-4)
- 2. Let us WALK honestly, not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying (Rom 13:13)
- **3.** <u>Walk charitably</u> with your brother and do not grieve them over activities such as eating meat (Rom 14:15)
- 4. Envying, strife, and division are signs of carnality, <u>walking as men</u> (1 Cor. 3:3)
- 5. Disciples should <u>not WALK in craftiness</u>, <u>nor handle the WORD of GOD</u> deceitfully, (2 Cor. 4:2)







Apostles' discussion on walking with JESUS CHRIST

- 6. Disciples must WALK by faith, and not by sight (2 Cor. 5:7)
- 7. <u>GOD will dwell</u> in Disciples, and <u>WALK in them</u>; He will be their GOD, and they shall be His people (2 Cor. 6:16)
- <u>Though</u> we <u>WALK in the flesh</u>, we <u>should not war after the flesh</u> (2 Cor. 10:3)
- 9. Paul said Peter did not <u>WALK uprightly according to the truth</u> of the Gospel (Gal 2:14)
- 10. WALK in the SPIRIT, and you will not fulfil the lust of the flesh (Gal. 5:16)
- 11. If we live in the SPIRIT, let us also WALK in the SPIRIT (Gal. 5:25)
- 12. We should WALK according to the rules of GOD (Gal. 6:16)







Apostles' discussion on walking with JESUS CHRIST

- 13. Disciples should <u>not WALK</u> according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience (Eph. 2:2)
- 14. GOD ordained that we should WALK in good works (Eph. 4:1)
- 15. WALK in love, as CHRIST also hath loved us (Eph. 5:2)
- 16. We were sometime darkness, now are ye light in the LORD: WALK as children of light (Eph. 5:8)
- 17. <u>WALK circumspectly</u>, not as fools, but as wise (Eph. 5:15)
- 18. Whereunto you have <u>already attained</u>, let us <u>WALK</u> by the same rule, let us mind the same thing (Phil. 3:16)

Apostles' discussion on walking with JESUS CHRIST

- 19. Mark those who WALK as Paul as an example (Col. 2:6)
- 20. <u>WALK in wisdom</u> toward them that are without, redeeming the time (Col. 4:5)
- 21. That ye would WALK worthy of GOD, who hath called you unto his kingdom and glory (1 Thess. 2:12)
- 22. Disciples commanded to withdraw from every brother that WALKETH disorderly, and not after the traditions they had received from Paul (2 Thess. 3:6)
- 23. Paul heard that some Disciples were WALKING disorderly, working not at all, but are busybodies (2 Thess. 3:11)







Apostles' discussion on walking with JESUS CHRIST

- 24. Peter <u>warned</u> about those who <u>WALK after the lust of the flesh</u> (2 Pet. 2:10)
- 25. Peter <u>warned</u> that there would come scoffers in the last days, WALKING after their own lusts (2 Pet. 3:3)
- 26. If we say we have fellowship with JESUS, and WALK in darkness, WE LIE, and DO NOT THE TRUTH (1 John 1:6)
- 27. Disciples are to WALK in the LIGHT, as JESUS is in the LIGHT (1 John 1:7)
- 28. He that abideth in JESUS <u>OUGHT</u> to <u>WALK even as</u> JESUS <u>WALKED</u> (1 John 2:6)
- 29. He that <u>HATETH</u> his BROTHER is <u>IN DARKNESS</u>, and <u>WALKETH in DARKNESS</u> (1 John 2:11)

Apostles' discussion on walking with JESUS CHRIST

- 30. John rejoiced that he found Disciples <u>WALKING in truth</u>, as he had received a commandment from the FATHER (2 John 1:4)
- 31. This is LOVE, that Disciples WALK after the FATHER's commandments (2 John 1:6)
- 32. John rejoiced as Disciples WALKED in the truth (3 John 1:3)
- 33. John had no greater joy that when Disciples WALK in truth (3 John 1:4)
- 34. GOD's judgments will be <u>EXECUTED</u> against those who <u>WALK after their</u> <u>OWN LUSTS</u> (Jude 1:15-16)
- 35. JUDE <u>WARNS</u> against <u>MOCKERS</u> in the LAST TIMES, who would <u>WALK after</u> <u>their OWN UNGODLY LUSTS</u> (Jude 1:18)



Walking as Disciples



JESUS CHRIST's JUDGMENT of Disciples who DEFILE their LIVES!

Revelations 3:1-6

- And unto the angel of the church in Sardis write; These things saith he that hath the seven <u>SPIRITS of GOD</u>, and the seven stars; <u>I KNOW THY WORKS</u>, that thou hast a name that thou livest, and <u>ART DEAD</u>.
- Be watchful, and STRENGTHEN the things which REMAIN, that are READY to DIE: for <u>I HAVE NOT FOUND THY WORKS PERFECT</u> BEFORE GOD.
- REMEMBER therefore HOW THOU HAST <u>RECEIVED</u> and <u>HEARD</u>, and <u>HOLD FAST</u>, and <u>REPENT</u>. IF therefore THOU SHALT NOT WATCH, I will COME ON THEE as a <u>THIEF</u>, and thou <u>SHALT NOT KNOW WHAT HOUR I</u> WILL COME UPON THEE.
- 4. Thou hast a FEW NAMES EVEN in <u>SARDIS</u> which <u>HAVE NOT DEFILED</u> THEIR GARMENTS; and they <u>SHALL WALK WITH ME</u> IN WHITE: for THEY ARE WORTHY.
- He that <u>OVERCOMETH</u>, the SAME shall be CLOTHED in WHITE RAINMENT; and I WILL <u>NOT BLOT OUT</u> HIS NAME OUT OF THE BOOK OF LIFE, but I WILL CONFESS HIS NAME BEFORE MY FATHER, and before his angels.
- 6. He that HATH AN EAR, let him HEAR what the SPIRIT SAITH UNTO the CHURCHES.
